NFPA HYBRID & ELECTRIC VEHICLE TRAINING

The CFA will be hosting the first in a series of three deliveries of NFPA's Hybrid and Electric vehicle training for first responders in CT. This training is free of charge and sponsored by the Greater New Haven Clean Cities and Capital Clean Cities of Connecticut. The first delivery will be held at the CFA on Saturday June 17th (0900 – 1300 hrs) with two additional dates to be announced shortly for the fall in Eastern and Southern CT.

The training will consist of an introduction to HEVs/EVs, basic electrical concepts and hazards, HEV/EV exhicle types, batteries and systems, initial response actions-including vehicle identification, immobilization and disabling procedures. Also addressed will be extrication operations, battery breaches, vehicle submersion, vehicle fires, post incident handling of vehicles and incidents involving charging stations. Connecticut specific response considerations will also be addressed, including the best practices documents for EVs, fixed energy storage and micromobility devices as released by the Commission on Fire Prevention and Control.

Instructor Bio:

A 33-year veteran of the fire service, Battalion Chief Jason Emery has been with the Waterbury FD (CT) for 28 years. Jason has served as a Subject Matter Expert for the NFPA in various areas, and the lead instructor for their Alternative Fuel Vehicle safety training program. He is a member of the SAE 2990 Task Force: Hybrid and EV First and Second Responder Task Force. Jason instructed as part of the Chevrolet Volt training team for first responders throughout the United States. He has trained firefighters throughout the country and internationally in China, Korea, and Canada. He also has been a presenter at the Fire Department Instructors Conference (FDIC) annually since 2008. Jason holds a B.S. in Fire Investigation from the University of New Haven and founded Emergency Training Solutions, LLC.


