REGULATORY UPDATE – THREE MINOR AMENDMENTS

Components

- 1) The addition of the 0.070 parts per million ozone standard in RCSA section 22a-174-24.
- 2) The removal of the “affirmative defense” provision from RCSA section 22a-174-33 maintains consistency with a final rule EPA published on July 21, 2023 removing the emergency affirmative defense provisions from the CAA operating permit program (title V) regulations.

Removal of Title V Emergency Affirmative Defense Provisions From State Operating Permit Programs and Federal Operating Permit Program, 88 FR 47029 (July 21, 2023).

- 3) The correction to RCSA section 22a-174-44 clarifies the volatile organic compound (VOC) calculation methods available for adhesive and sealant products.

THREE SIP UPDATE FOR THE 2008 OZONE NAAQS RECLASSIFICATION TO SEVERE NON-ATTAINMENT FOR THE SOUTHWEST CT NON-ATTAINMENT AREA

Components

- 1) Reasonably available control technology (RACT) analysis
- 2) Certification of adequacy of the non-attainment new source review requirements
- 3) Emission statement certification
