## EV Charging Pilot Program

After working together with Clean Transportation – Western CT with Voltpost's pilot program on their mission to introduce charging access by deploying convenient and affordable charging across all communities, they've received commitments from multiple municipalities and communities to install 100 level 2 chargers in Eversource and UI territories which will be completed in mid to late 2026.

## Environmental Justice Community of Frog Hollow EV Infrastructure Project Completed

4 EV Chargers have been installed in the Parking Lot of Fire by Forge on Broad Street in Hartford

4 chargers installed in the Parking Lot of the Lyceum on Lawrence Street in Hartford

2 chargers installed in a multi-family housing unit on Lawrence Street in Hartford.

This project was made possible by working collaboratively with our stakeholders RLE (Resource Lighting & Energy) and Eversource along with assistance from our stakeholder Aaron Gill at Wolverine Properties assisting with working with the City of Hartford Permitting Department to make changes to existing laws due to buildings being located in a historical district.

## West Hartford Electric Showcase

Capitol Clean Cities of CT was on the Planning Committee with the Town of West Hartford for the West Hartford Electric Showcase on 9/20/25 which included 15 EV vehicles on display along with E-bikes, E-skooters, lawn equipment, heat pump and a solar panel tour. It was a very successful and well attended event. We had a booth available with distribution materials and offered Q&A and had a visit from the Mayor and the Associated Press.

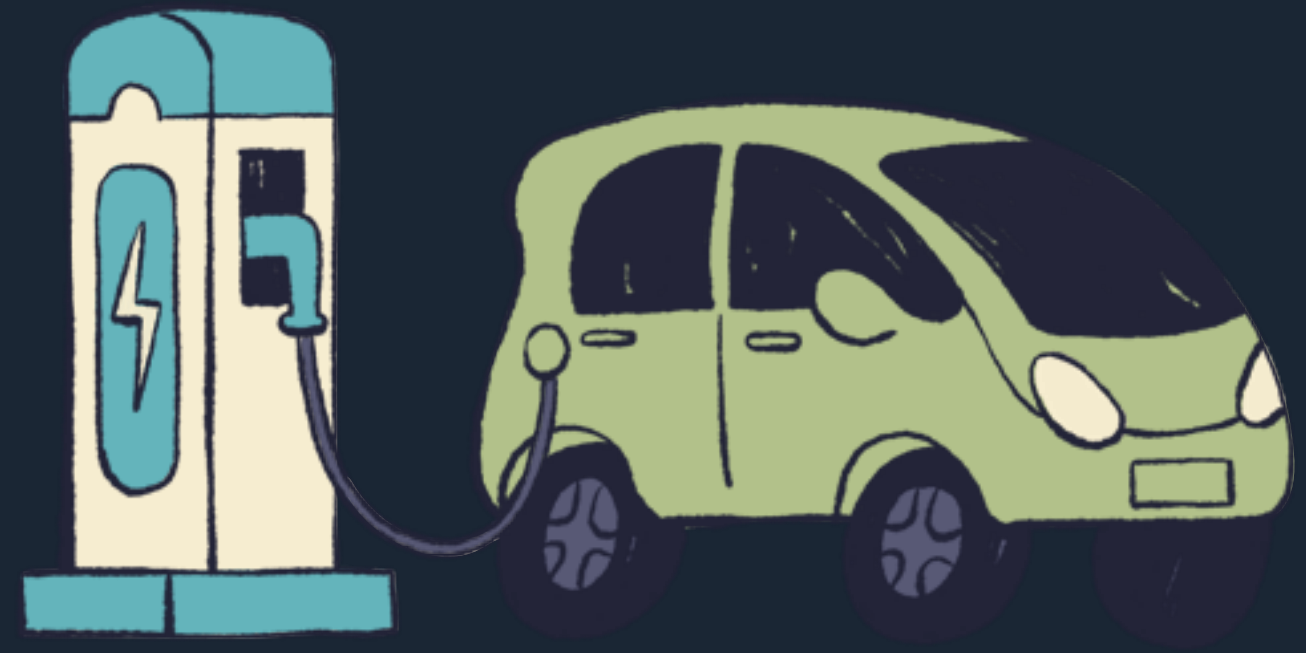

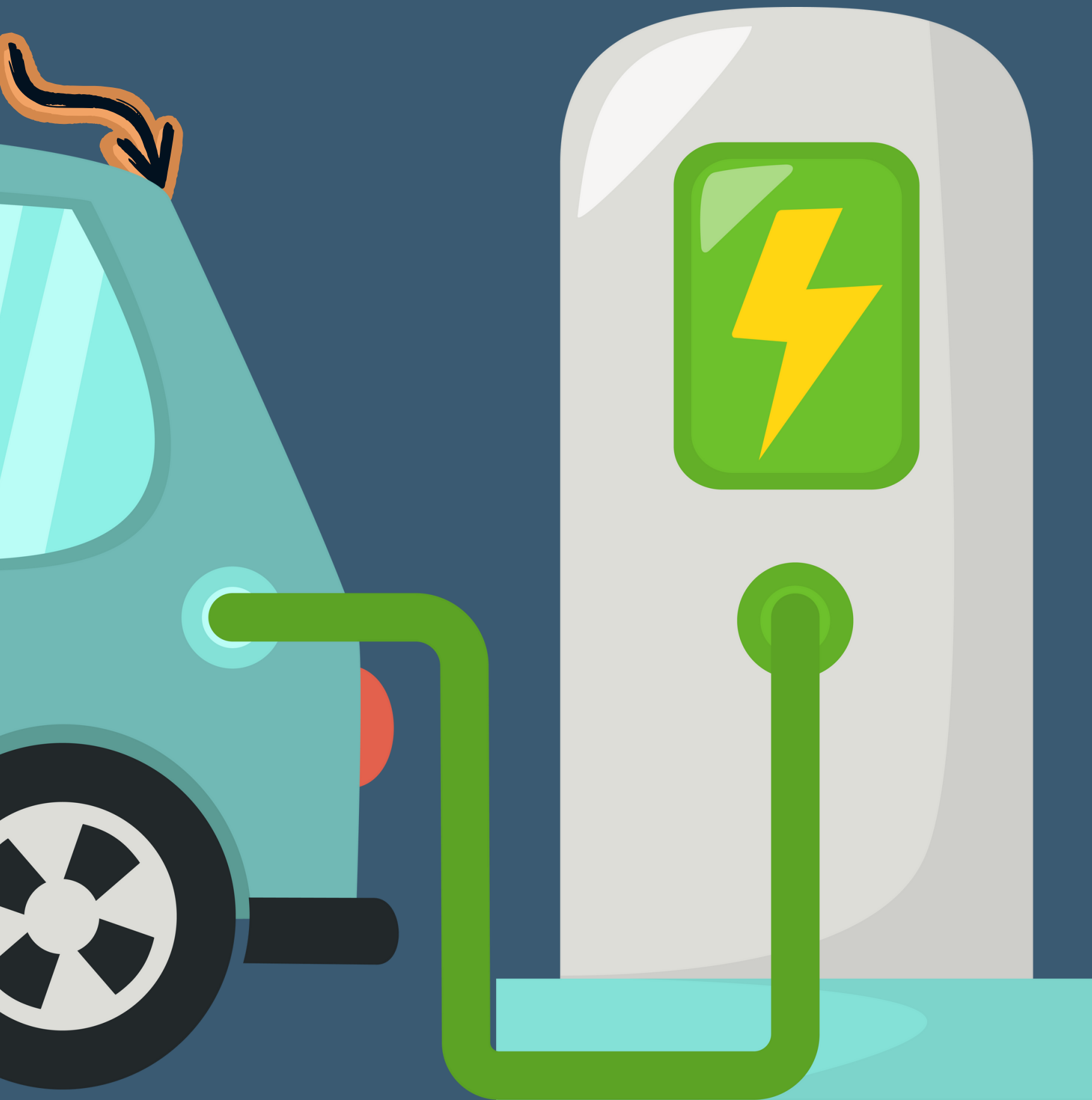
