TITLE V EMISSIONS REPORTING AND FEES

- EPA's CAAA of 1990 established federal rules requiring states to collect annual fees based on actual criteria pollutant emissions every calendar year.
- The total revenue from these fees must sufficiently cover the entire cost of administering the state's Title V program.
- The process for assessing Title V fees is specified in §22a-174-26 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA).

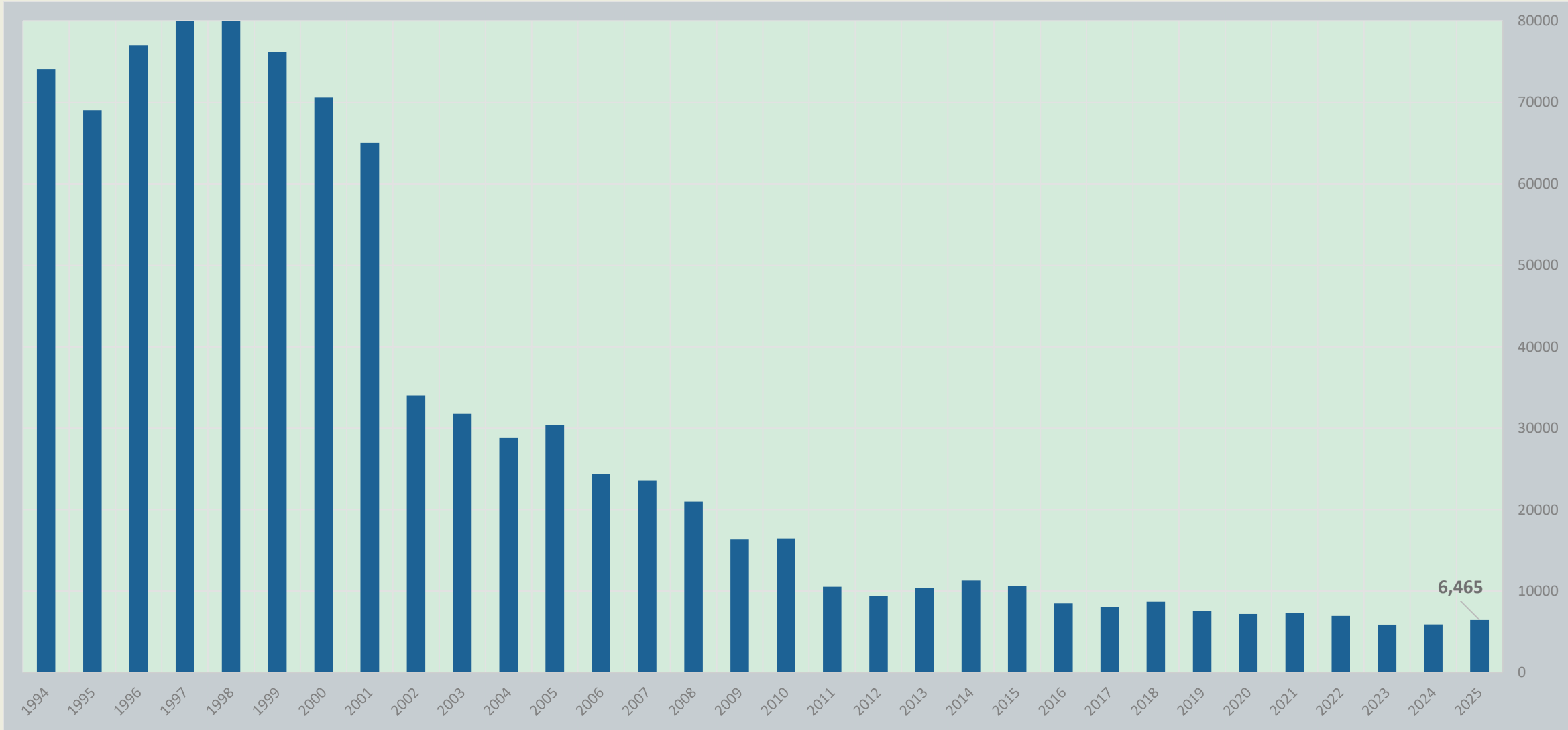
FACTS AND FIGURES FOR 2025 TITLE V FEES

- Inventory Stabilization Factor (ISF)

If unadjusted by the DEEP Commissioner the ISF will equal $133,665 / (2025 \text{ TOTAL})$ or 20.7. The actual ISF was reduced to 10.2 by our DEEP Commissioner K. Dykes, to meet required Title V program expenses.

- A total of 62 Title V sites received fee invoices for their 2025 emissions.
- All invoices were sent out electronically on June 1st.
- 2025 Emissions Fees were due on July 1st, 2026.
