Thank-you for providing the opportunity to review Connecticut DEEP's proposed Consent Order No. 8383 containing reasonably available control technology (RACT) requirements to limit volatile organic chemical (VOC) emissions from the Algonquin Transmission facility located at 252 Shunpike Road in Cromwell, CT. We have reviewed the proposed Order and agree with Connecticut's determination of RACT requirements for the facility.

Additionally, we are providing a comment to request that within Section 6.c of the proposed Order, the phrase "and EPA" be added after the word Commissioner. The proposed Order will become part of federal law if approved into the SIP, and records should be provided to EPA in addition to the Commissioner.
