



## **Pressure Management and Vapor Control Device Testing Requirements**

### **for Gasoline Dispensing Facilities**

#### *Regs. Conn. State Agencies § 22a-174-30a(d)(8)*

#### **FAQs**

##### **1. Who does this section apply to?**

- a. This section applies to the owner or operator of any gasoline dispensing facility (GDF) who has installed a pressure management or vapor control device on a storage tank with a capacity of 250 gallons or greater, other than a device that is required to be installed and tested by Regs. Conn. State Agencies § 22a-174-30a.

##### **2. What are pressure management or vapor control devices?**

- a. Pressure management or vapor control devices are systems designed to control and recover hydrocarbon vapors, reduce emissions, and potentially recover valuable fuel.

##### **3. What do I have to do to comply with this section?**

- a. You must test the pressure management or vapor control device annually by a method approved by the Commissioner;
- b. At least sixty (60) days prior to conducting an annual test, you must submit a test protocol for review and approval on a form provided by the Commissioner;
- c. You also need to conduct annual Stage I vapor recovery testing as required by Regs. Conn. State Agencies § 22a-174-30a(d). The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) prefers Stage I vapor recovery testing to be conducted on the same day as any pressure management or vapor control device testing to prove there is no compatibility issues between the two systems.
