



### Directions on How to Purchase your Boating Certificate

1. Go to the Online Sportsmen Licensing System  
<https://ct.aspirafocus.com/internetsales>

2. Under the “**Returning Customer**,” click on the drop down for “**Select One Identity Type**” and choose Conservation ID, enter your Conservation Id in the “**Enter your Identity Value**” box, enter your last name and date of birth where indicated. Under season, select the current season. Click log in.

Please note: If you have a Connecticut Hunting or Fishing License, your Conservation ID Number will be the same ID Number that was assigned with the Hunting or Fishing license.

3. If you are having trouble logging in to your account, please **do not create a new account**, your credentials will be loaded under your original conservation ID.
