¹ The Blue Plan was approved by the Connecticut General Assembly on May 14, 2021, and must be updated at least once every five years after plan approval. Therefore, any Blue Plan/Inventory updates must be submitted to the General Assembly for approval during the legislative session that starts February 2026. Legislative approval will again entail “the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment” to conduct a public hearing on the plan.
