- Blue Plan approved by the Connecticut General Assembly on May 14, 2021
- CGS §25-157t(h)(4): Upon approval of such inventory and plan... the Commissioner
 of Energy and Environmental Protection shall provide for the review and update of
 such inventory and plan at least once every five years and any revision to such
 inventory and plan shall become effective upon approval by the General Assembly,
 in accordance with subsection (g) of this section (emphasis added)
- CGS §25-157t(g): Upon completion of the final draft of the Long Island Sound Blue Plan, such plan shall be submitted to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment. Said committee, not later than forty-five days after the start of the next occurring legislative session following receipt of such plan, shall conduct a public hearing on the plan. Not later than forty-five days after such public hearing, said committee shall submit such plan, in conjunction with the committee's recommendation for approval or disapproval of such plan, to the General Assembly. Such plan shall become effective when approved by a majority vote of each chamber of the General Assembly. In the event that the General Assembly disapproves the plan, in whole or in part, such plan shall be deemed to be rejected and shall be returned to the advisory committee for revision
