Re: Plainfield Renewable Energy, LLC ("PRE") In-Service Date

In reference to that certain Standard Electricity Purchase Agreement by and between The Connecticut Light and Power Company ("Utility") and Plainfield Renewable Energy, LLC ("Seller") dated May 8, 2008, as amended on September 17, 2010, and further amended on December 23, 2011 (the "EPA"), CL&P is in receipt of Seller's notice dated December 31, 2013 stating that the PRE facility had achieved the requirements for the facility to be considered In-Service in accordance with Appendix B; and that, with the possible exception of Class I certification, the PRE facility had satisfied the Prerequisites for Purchases set forth in Section A-15 of the EPA. On April 9, 2014, the Connecticut Public Utilities Regulatory Authority issued a decision approving Class I certification of the PRE facility effective as of December 12, 2013.

CL&P hereby accepts said documentation and agrees that the In-Service Date of the Facility shall be recorded as 2400 hours on December 31, 2013 with purchases at the Contract Payment Rate to begin as of 00:00 on January 1, 2014. In accordance with Section 5.1 of the EPA, said EPA shall remain in effect for fifteen (15) years from the In-Service Date and shall terminate, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the terms of the EPA, at 2400 hours on December 31, 2028. Following the end of the term, the parties shall have no further obligation under the EPA except as otherwise expressly provided in the EPA or to the extent necessary to enforce the rights and obligations of the parties arising under the EPA before the end of the term.

In reference to Appendix B of the EPA *Description of Facility*, the Delivery Point shall be the PTF line 1505 adjacent to the new ISO-NE Network Node ID15509 UN.PLNFIELD13.8PLFD.
