Introducing Laptop ConneCT



WHAT IS IT?

Laptop ConneCT establishes long-term lending of laptops and related accessories to eligible Connecticut residents through local public libraries.

The Laptop ConneCT Program is administered by the CT Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) in partnership with the Connecticut State Library. This program is funded by the American Rescue Plan Act.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible to receive a laptop if you*:

- Are at least 18 years old
- Have a valid library card
- Participate in a qualifying state or federal assistance program

* If you need a library card or help signing up for assistance, your local library can help.
