Get connected with a laptop from your public library!

WHAT IS IT?

Laptop ConneCT lets eligible Connecticut residents borrow a laptop and accessories for long-term use from a participating local library.

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

You can apply for a laptop if you*:

- Are at least 18 years old
- Have a valid library card

You must also be in one of the following assistance programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP)
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Medicare
- HUSKY Health (Medicaid/The Children's Health Insurance Program)

* If you need a library card or help signing up for assistance, your local library can help.

WHAT TYPE OF LAPTOP WILL I RECEIVE?

You will be lent a Dell Pro 16 with the Windows operating system. It has a built-in camera for video calls, online classes, doctor appointments, and more. You will also receive a carrying case, power adapter, and charging cable.

Each laptop comes with a 5-year warranty through AGi Protect Plus. If you have issues with your laptop, you can contact the device supplier directly for help with repairs or tech support.

The warranty provides:

- Unlimited accidental damage repairs
- 5 years of battery coverage with unlimited replacements
- Prepaid shipping
- Expected turnaround time of 3–7 days

WHAT STEPS DO I NEED TO TAKE?

Before you get your laptop, **you must attend two meetings** at your library:

1 Eligibility & Intake:
A meeting with your librarian to check if you qualify.

2 Skills Training & Device Distribution:
A session to learn how to use your laptop and pick it up.
