

REVISED Notice of Meeting and Request for Written Comments
Commercial & Industrial and Residential Combined
Contractor Technical Advisory Committee
June 7, 2024

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245m, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) is required to review a combined electric and gas Conservation and Load Management (C&LM) Plan. Under § 16-245m, the C&LM Plan implements “cost-effective energy conservation programs, demand management and market transformation initiatives.” Eversource Energy, The United Illuminating Company, the Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation, and the Southern Connecticut Gas Company (collectively the “Utilities”) develop the C&LM Plan on three-year cycles with guidance from DEEP and the Energy Efficiency Board (EEB) and submit annual updates.

To assist with program implementation, DEEP regularly holds Contractor Technical Advisory Committee (CTAC) meetings with contractors from the Residential and Commercial & Industrial (C&I) sectors. These meetings provide a bi-monthly forum for contractors, the Utilities, and DEEP to discuss matters related to C&LM program implementation, and to submit public comments to aid DEEP in its ongoing decision-making process. Other stakeholders are welcome to participate as well. The recommendations of this working group and written comments submitted by stakeholders will be informative to DEEP in its continued oversight of the C&LM Plan and programs.

DEEP will hold the next CTAC meeting on **Thursday, June 20, 2024, at 10:00 AM**. This is a hybrid meeting; attendees may participate via Zoom or in-person. This meeting is open to both Residential and C&I contractors. The meeting will consist of a review of the IRA Rebate Programs and contractor input, and a period for contractor open discussion. ***DEEP will be providing the agenda in advance of the meeting and is seeking input on specific agenda items that the contractors would like to cover.*** Written comments from stakeholders will be due on **June 28, 2024**.
