2022 Procurement Plan

- IRP schedule for future procurements
 - Changed circumstances warrant updated procurement schedule
 - Statutory 100% zero carbon electric sector goal
 - Project terminations
 - Storage procurement authority
 - Transmission resources and constraints
 - Federal funding and incentives
 - Solid waste management challenges



2022 Procurement Plan – Next Steps

Solar procurement

- Q4 2022:
 - Release a notice of proceeding outlining scoping questions (resources to procure, amount, etc.)
 - Stakeholder workshop on solar siting
 - Release draft RFP for public comment
- Q1 2023:
 - Release final RFP seeking bids
 - Bidders' conference



2022 Procurement Plan – Next Steps

- Storage procurement
 - Released a notice of next steps
 - Q4 2022:
 - Conduct modeling to find storage use cases that can:
 - Displace fossil generation, particularly in EJ communities
 - Interconnect new large electric loads
 - Support integration of renewables
 - Q1 2023:
 - Release draft RFP and host public meeting with details on targeted use cases and take public comment
 - Q2 2023:
 - Release final RFP seeking bids
 - Bidders' conference
 - Discussion of storage benefits



2022 Procurement Plan – Next Steps

- Transmission
 - Released RFI, comments due October 28
 - Technical meeting held on October 7
 - Q4 2022:
 - Monitor for DOE funding opportunity announcements
- Anaerobic digestion
 - Q4 2022:
 - Release RFI and hold technical meeting on waste technologies and policy goals of the state
