NOTICE OF WRITTEN COMMENT OPPORTUNITY EXTENSION

Pursuant to Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 440, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) has updated the State's Program Year 2026 Plan for administering a single-family (1-4 unit) Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) for low-income persons (proposed WAP PY26 State Plan) and held two virtual public hearings on Zoom. The draft of the proposed WAP PY26 State Plan will be posted on www.ct.gov/deep/weatherization. The virtual public hearings on this Plan were held on Wednesday April 15, 2026, from 10:30AM to 12:00PM and 4:00PM to 5:30PM. By way of this Notice, DEEP is extending the opportunity for interested people to submit written comments on the draft of the proposed WAP PY26 State Plan.
