



## **Commercial Black Sea Bass Possession Limit Change**

### **NOTICE**

#### **Black sea bass**

**Effective 0001 hours, Sunday, May 17, 2020 the possession limit for the commercial harvest of black sea bass will be 60 pounds.**

The Department monitors landings and adjusts trip limits according to Department regulations in an attempt to provide fishing opportunity throughout the year for all participants in the commercial fishery. In addition, the Department strives to provide advance notification of trip limit changes, although this may not always be possible due to rapidly escalating or unanticipated landings. In such circumstances, only a short notification period may be possible.
