## **Commercial Summer Flounder Fishery Possession Limit Change**

## **NOTICE**

Effective 0001 hours Sunday, April 23, 2023, the daily possession limit for the commercial harvest of summer flounder will be 250 pounds.

As of Wednesday, April 19, 2023, the Department estimates more than 34% of Connecticut's 2023 commercial summer flounder quota has been landed. The 2023 Winter I (January 1 through April 30) cumulative landings target for the commercial fishery is 35% of the quota. The reduced possession limit of 250 pounds should avoid or minimize a Winter 1 target overage while still allowing for incidental landings during the remainder of the Winter I period.
