Commercial Possession Limit Decrease

NOTICE

Effective 0001 hours, Sunday, July 30, 2023, the following possession limits will be in effect for Connecticut's commercial scup fishery:

Scup:

- 1,500 pounds for holder of a Scup License Endorsement
- For Restricted Commercial Fishing License holders: 100 fish
- From lobster pots, when in possession of lobsters: 10 fish. This does not apply to personal use license holders.

The Department estimates, as of Wednesday, July 26, 2023, 86% of Connecticut's summer period commercial scup quota had been landed. Through a generous transfer of 150,000 pounds from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the summer period commercial scup fishery will remain open at a 1,500 lb trip limit until 100% of the adjusted summer period quota (522,110 lbs) has been landed, or through September 30, 2023, whichever occurs first.
