

## STOCKING UPDATE AS OF 02/04/2025:

Winter is full-on and so is winter stocking! We continue to roll out our broodstock Seeforellen Brown Trout. We hold them for a few weeks at the hatchery after spawning to get their biomass back up, their colors shining, and to recondition them. They go weeks on end being handled and food deprived during the spawning process, which can be stressful. Thanks for your patience and please enjoy!

Also, with the New Year comes new opportunities. We are stocking trout into select lakes/ponds and rivers/streams throughout January and February as conditions allow, to provide anglers opportunities during winter. Responses from public surveys indicate that many Connecticut anglers spend a large portion of their annual fishing effort during winter months and have encouraged more year-round stocking. We agree! It's a great time to get outdoors and track down trout. We will be focusing on waterbodies with no special regulations. Please enjoy and be safe. Note - the Fisheries Division does not monitor or routinely report ice conditions. Use caution, routinely test ice thickness, go with a friend, and consider taking a child to teach them the ropes. "The Daily Cast" – Broodstock Seefs from Kensington Hatchery to a few Trout Management Lakes today including, East Twin Lake, West Hill Pond, and Squantz Pond. Rainbows from Quinebaug Hatchery were stocked in the other three locations.

The following is a list of waters planned to be stocked by the Fisheries Division during **fall/winter 2024/2025**. Dates will be added daily to the "Stocked" column in the table below as locations are stocked and any relevant details will be noted in the "Daily Cast" section above. Please get out and enjoy. Please note that due to a variety of conditions not every river/stream stocking location can be stocked on each stocking run. The information is sorted alphabetically by waterbody name first in table 1 and by town name in table 2.
