STOCKING UPDATE AS OF 02/02/2026:

Winter is full-on and so is winter stocking! With the New Year comes new opportunities. We will be stocking upwards of 50,000 trout (including our prized Seeforellen strain Brown trout) into select lakes/ponds throughout January and February as conditions allow, to provide anglers opportunities during winter. Responses from public surveys indicate that many Connecticut anglers spend a large portion of their annual fishing effort during winter months and have encouraged more year-round stocking. We agree! It's a great time to get outdoors and track down trout. Please enjoy and be safe. Note - the Fisheries Division does not monitor or routinely report ice conditions. Use caution, routinely test ice thickness, go with a friend, and consider taking a child to teach them the ropes. Read more ice safety guidelines [here](#).

"The Daily Cast" – 5,000 trout to several lakes to kick off the week! Also, coming up are the broodstock Seeforellen brown trout from Kensington hatchery. These amazing fish have been putting back on their biomass after spawning and they are now colored up, strong, and beautiful. They will begin to get stocked in about one week so stay tuned! Please enjoy and be safe.
