

Directions:

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 68. Stay straight after exit to go on US-1, follow this for 0.4 miles. Make a slight left onto Route I54/Main Street. Continue on Route I54/Main Street for 2.1 miles. Turn right onto Bridge Street. End at 2 Bridge Street and Saybrook Point will be on your left.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 67, turn slight right onto Route 154, follow for 0.5 miles. Turn slight left on Route 154/Main Street, follow for 2.1 miles. Then make a right onto Bridge Street. End at 2 Bridge Street and Saybrook Point will be on your left.
