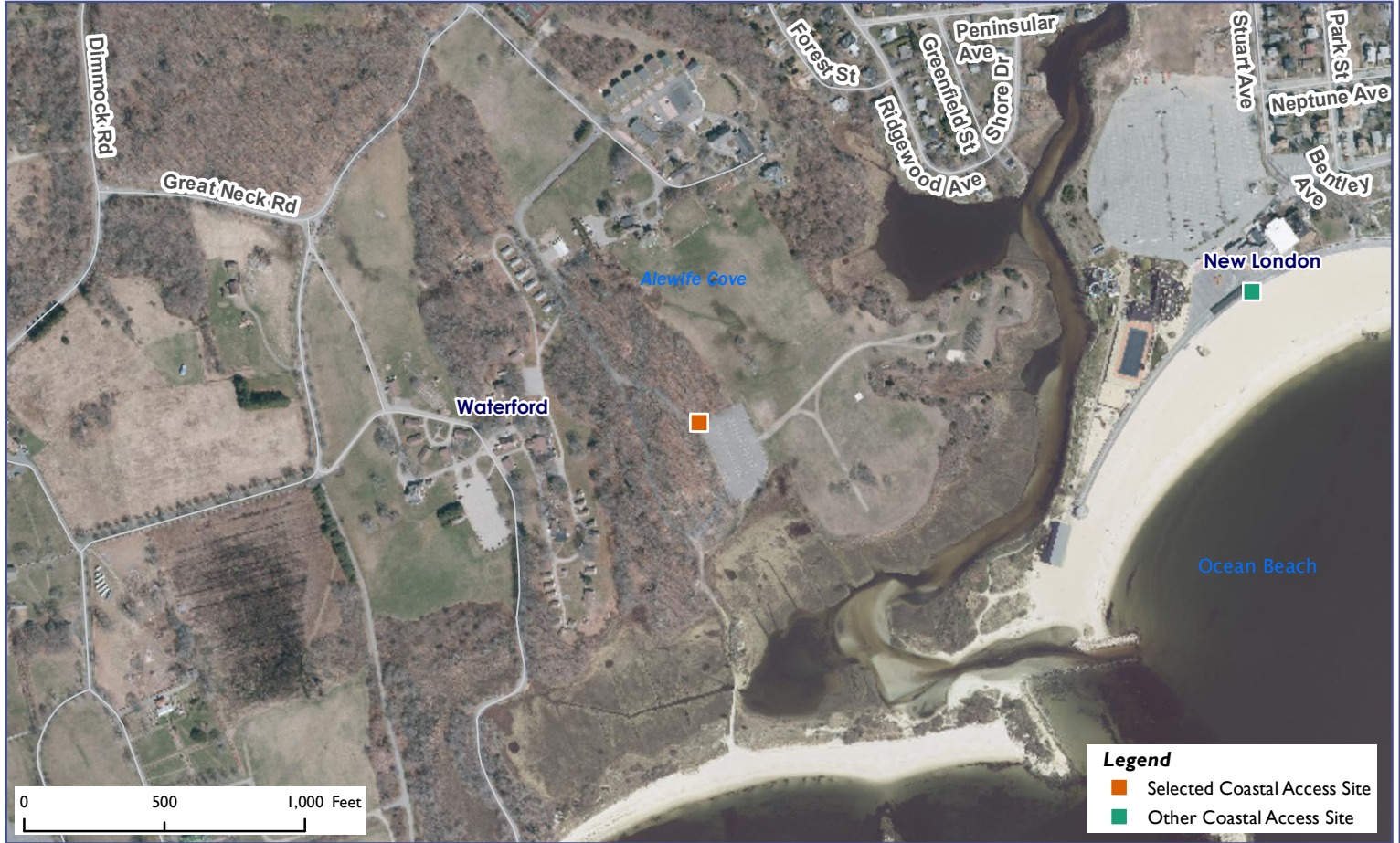


Connecticut Coastal Access Guide

Site Description: Waterford Beach Park offers visitors a rare opportunity to experience a largely unmodified Long Island Sound beach, dune and saltmarsh complex. Approximately 1/4 mile of the Park's shoreline provides one of the best examples of an intact beach and dune system in Connecticut where the State-threatened piping plover occasionally nests. Please avoid areas marked as beach nesting bird habitat. Handicapped accessible beach wheelchairs available. Season passes are sold through the Parks and Recreation Department. Lifeguards on duty, conditions permitting, during the summer. Follow signs to the adjacent Eugene O'Neil Theater to find this site off of Great Neck Road. Consult the Town of Waterford's website or call the Parks and Recreation Department (860-444-5881) for a current fee schedule.



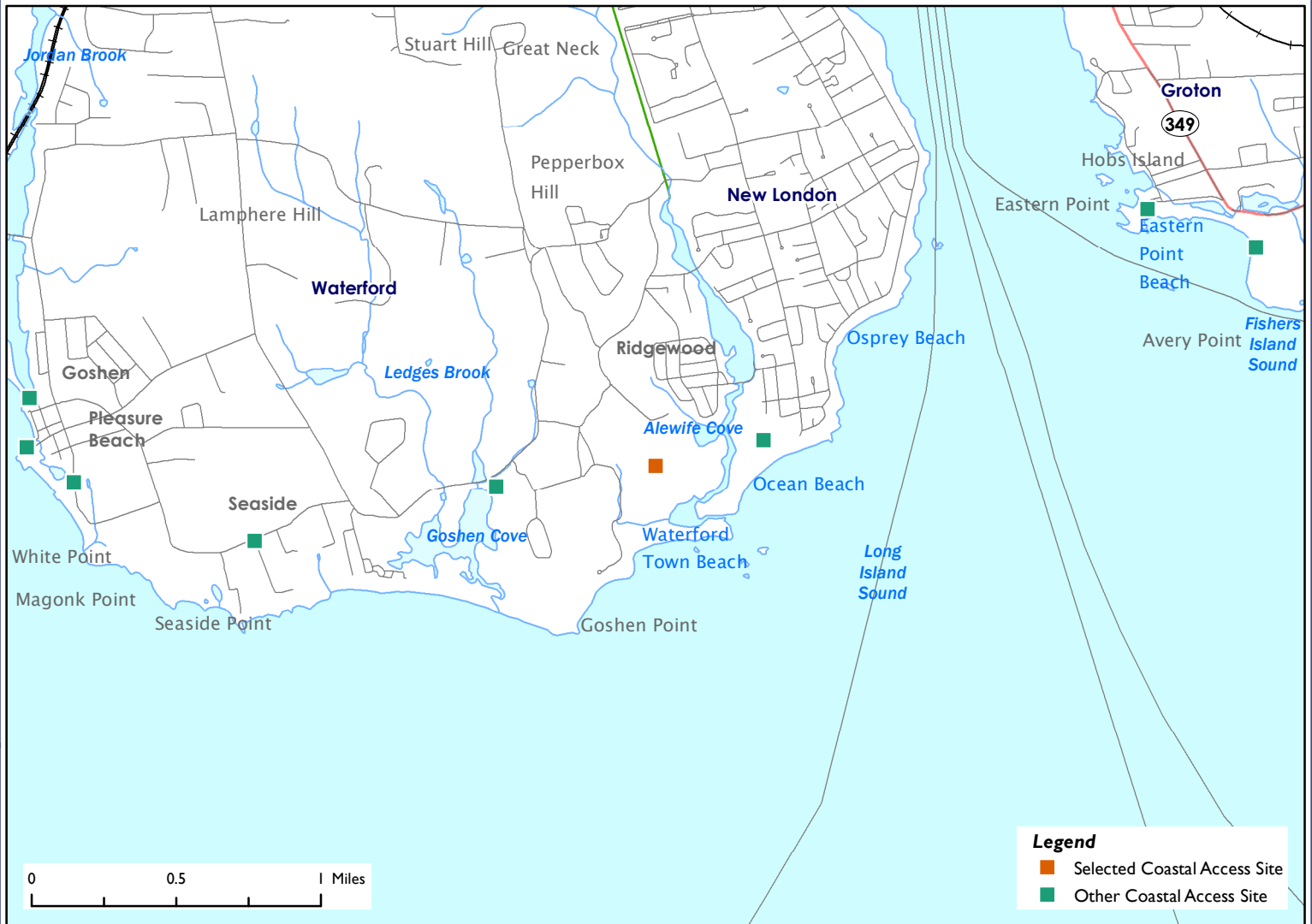

Directions:

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 84 South (Route 32). Route 32 becomes Eugene O'Neill Drive. Turn right onto Governor Winthrop Boulevard. Turn left onto Huntington Street. Turn right onto Jay Street. Jay Street becomes Truman Street. Turn right onto Bank Street. Turn left onto Route 213/Ocean Avenue for 1.9 miles. Turn right onto Route 213/Niles Hill Road. Route 213 becomes Great Neck Road.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 81. Turn left onto Parkway South. Turn right onto Cross Road. Turn slight left onto Boston Post Road. Turn right onto Avery Lane. Avery Lane becomes Route 213/Great Neck Road. Turn left onto Braman Road for 1.1 miles. Turn right onto Dimmock Road. Turn left onto Route 213/Great Neck Road.
