

Site Description: Seaside Park is an extensive municipal park with many amenities including a bathing beach, bath houses, ball fields, picnic areas, and hiking trails.





From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 27 Lafayette Boulevard. Take Univ. of Bridgeport/Trans. Center ramp. Stay straight on South Avenue 0.2 miles. Turn left onto Park Avenue.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 27 Lafayette Boulevard/Downtown 0.1 miles. Turn right onto Myrtle Avenue. Turn right onto Railroad Avenue 0.1 miles. Turn left onto Park Avenue 0.4 miles.
