

# Connecticut Coastal Access Guide

Bradley Point Park

Captain Thomas Boulevard West Haven, CT 06516



**Site Description:** Bradley Point Park includes a small sandy beach and a developed walkway parallel to Long Island Sound. Park benches on-site provide vantage points for visitors to enjoy extensive views. Three sets of permanent posts for impromptu volleyball games are available on the sandy beach (in-season), thereby broadening the number of possible recreational opportunities for visitors. A temporary portable toilet serves as the only restroom facility on-site. A spectacular 4th of July fireworks display occurs annually. On-site parking is available for 40 vehicles; contact the West Haven Parks & Recreation Department for parking fee schedule (effective from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Weekend annually). Most beach-parking lots in West Haven close at 11:30 p.m. on a daily basis, although the walkway is open 24 hours per day, year-round.



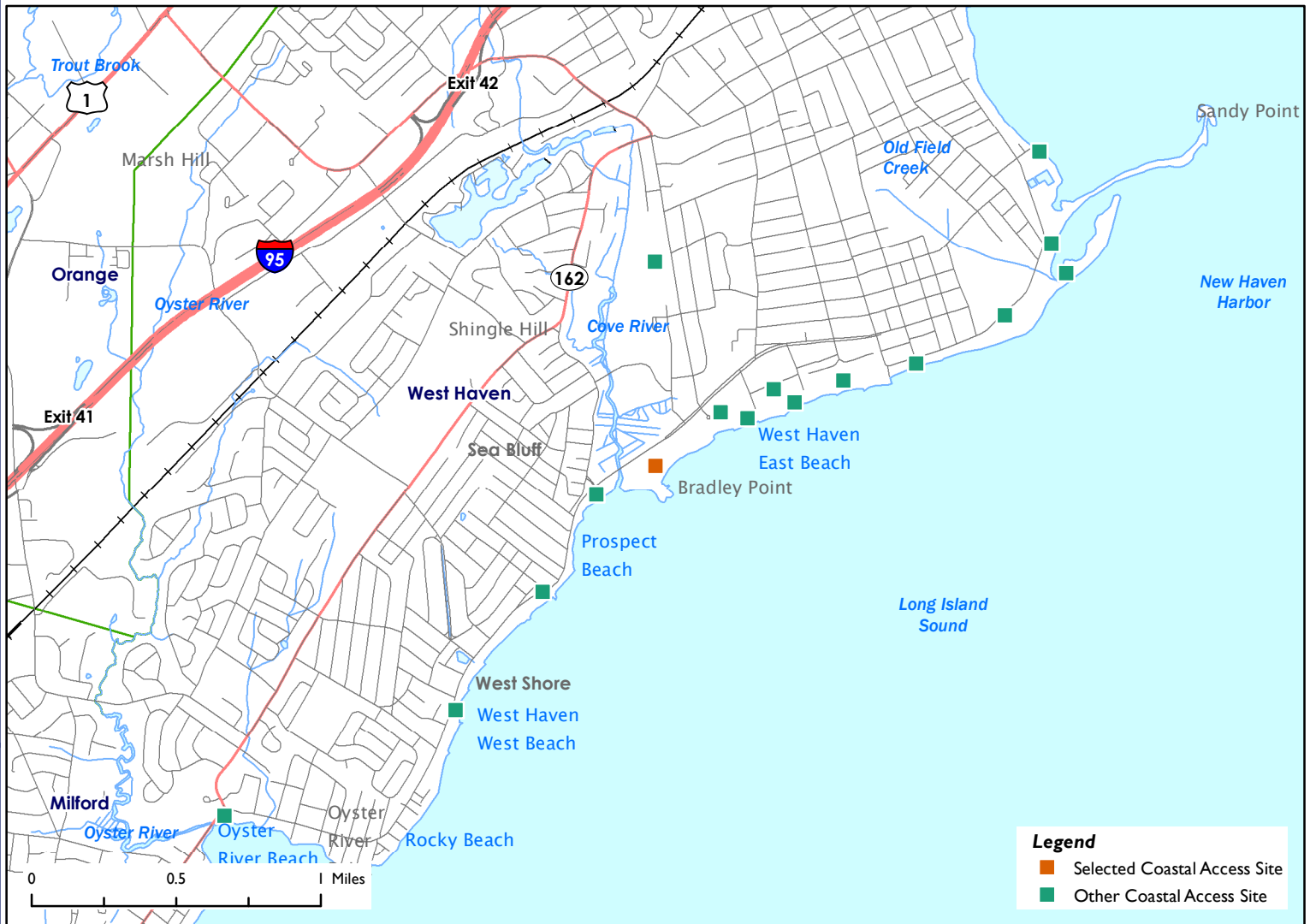

## Directions:

From the East: Take I-95 South to Exit 44. At the end of the exit ramp, continue straight onto Route 122/Kimberly Avenue and proceed .4 miles to the intersection of I Avenue. Proceed straight onto Elm Street and follow 1.1 miles. Next, turn left onto Route 162/Wagner Place and follow .1 mile. At the intersection of Main Street, continue straight (by embarking upon Kelsey Avenue) for 1 mile. Next, turn right onto Captain Thomas Boulevard and proceed .2 miles. The entrance to Bradley Point Park will be on the left.

From the West: Take I-95 North to Exit 42. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 162/Sawmill Road and proceed .7 miles. At the intersection of Main Street and Kelsey Avenue, proceed straight for 1 mile. Next, turn right onto Captain Thomas Boulevard and continue .2 miles. The entrance to Bradley Point Park will be on the left.
