
# **Connecticut Coastal Access Guide**

To access the Park's car-top boat launch, follow signs to Meigs Point and the fishermen's parking area. The launch is on east side of Meigs Point jetty.



From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 62. Take a right off the exit and go approximately I mile. Go straight through the traffic light crossing Route I (Boston Post Road) into the park.
