

Site Description: This site is situated in the village of Stonington Borough. Although much of the waterfront property in this village has been converted to residential use, there is still an active marine commercial fishing fleet in the harbor. An interpretive sign at the pier describes the village's maritime history. Sailboats are commonly seen racing in this area. This site provides ample parking near the Town's wastewater treatment facility.



Take I-95 to exit 91. Head south on Pequot Trail/Route 234 to Stonington. Turn left onto North Main Street and follow for 2.3 miles. Make a left onto Trumbull Avenue. In 427 ft, turn right onto Alpha Avenue. After 0.2 mi turn left onto Water Street. After 0.2 mi, turn right onto Pearl St and follow to the end to reach the parking lot.
