

Instructions for Obtaining Daily Permits Online

- You must first have a hunting license that is valid for the current season or select one to
 purchase at the time you apply. All permits will be issued on an individual basis only. Group
 permits are not available. You may obtain only one permit per day from the list of available
 areas.
- 2. Go to the Connecticut Outdoor Licensing System.
- 3. Enter your Date of Birth, Last Name, and Conservation ID# and choose your season. Select **Submit** to log in. If you cannot log in, follow the instructions on the page for new or previous customers. If you have difficulty accessing your profile, or are unable to access hunting privileges following completion of a course, please contact us for assistance at 860-424-3011 (Wildlife Division) or 860-424-3105 (License and Revenue).
- 4. After logging in, check your profile information. If your profile information is not correct or is incomplete, select **Edit** to update your information.
- 5. Select Purchase Licenses to continue.
- 6. If you have not yet obtained a hunting license for the current year, add the type of license you want to your shopping cart.
- 7. Select the **Birds and Waterfowl** link at the top of the page.
- 8. Find **Daily Permit** on the list of items and select the **ADD** button.
- 9. You may then select an area and day to hunt. The menu will only display areas and dates for which daily permits are still available. Select the **SELECT** button to make your choice. The daily permit for the day you selected will be placed in your shopping cart. There is no charge for these permits.
- 10. You may add additional daily permits for different days or shop for other permits. You must complete your purchase in 15 minutes to ensure your permit selection will be available.
- 11. When finished, select **CHECK OUT to proceed.** Complete any required items and then select **CHECKOUT**.
- 12. Select **PRINT LICENSES/PERMIT and RECEIPT.** The hunting area and date that the daily permit is valid for will be printed on your Conservation License. You will need to reprint your license every time you obtain additional daily permits.
