Old Business:

Merritt Parkway Trail Study: town letters went out, Stamford group meeting to move it forward.

Restoration of license plate funds: continue to work on wording.

New Business/Updates:

- 1) Water trails (Lois): E. Conn, Quinebaug and Willimantic Rivers, large effort to log. Expect to hear in June. Guidebook to Willimantic River can be found on web.
- 2) Windsor Trail (Bob): base is laid and there will be a bridge by then end of the week. IT is a multi-use trail and includes horse use.
- 3) Nature Conservancy in Salem: public access, may create trail to connect to Rte. 11 area
- 4) CT Bike/Walk is looking for a new executive director.
- 5) Northeast Utilities (Tracy): in the process of getting access agreement done. Agreement with DEEP is expiring soon.
- 6) Mark P will ask for a meeting with DEEP Commissioner to update him on the Council's activities and initiatives.
