Site-specific with Review by DEEP

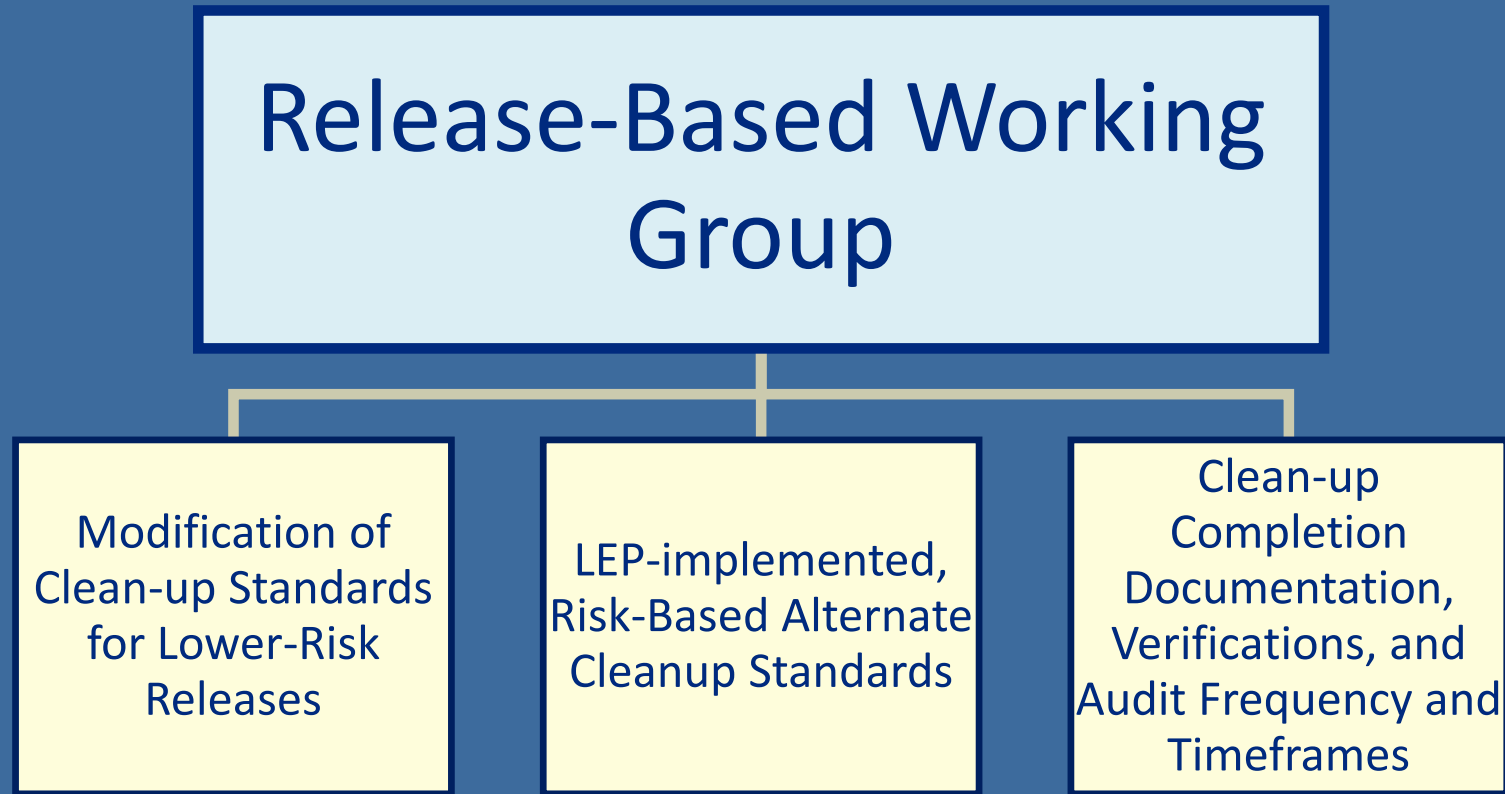

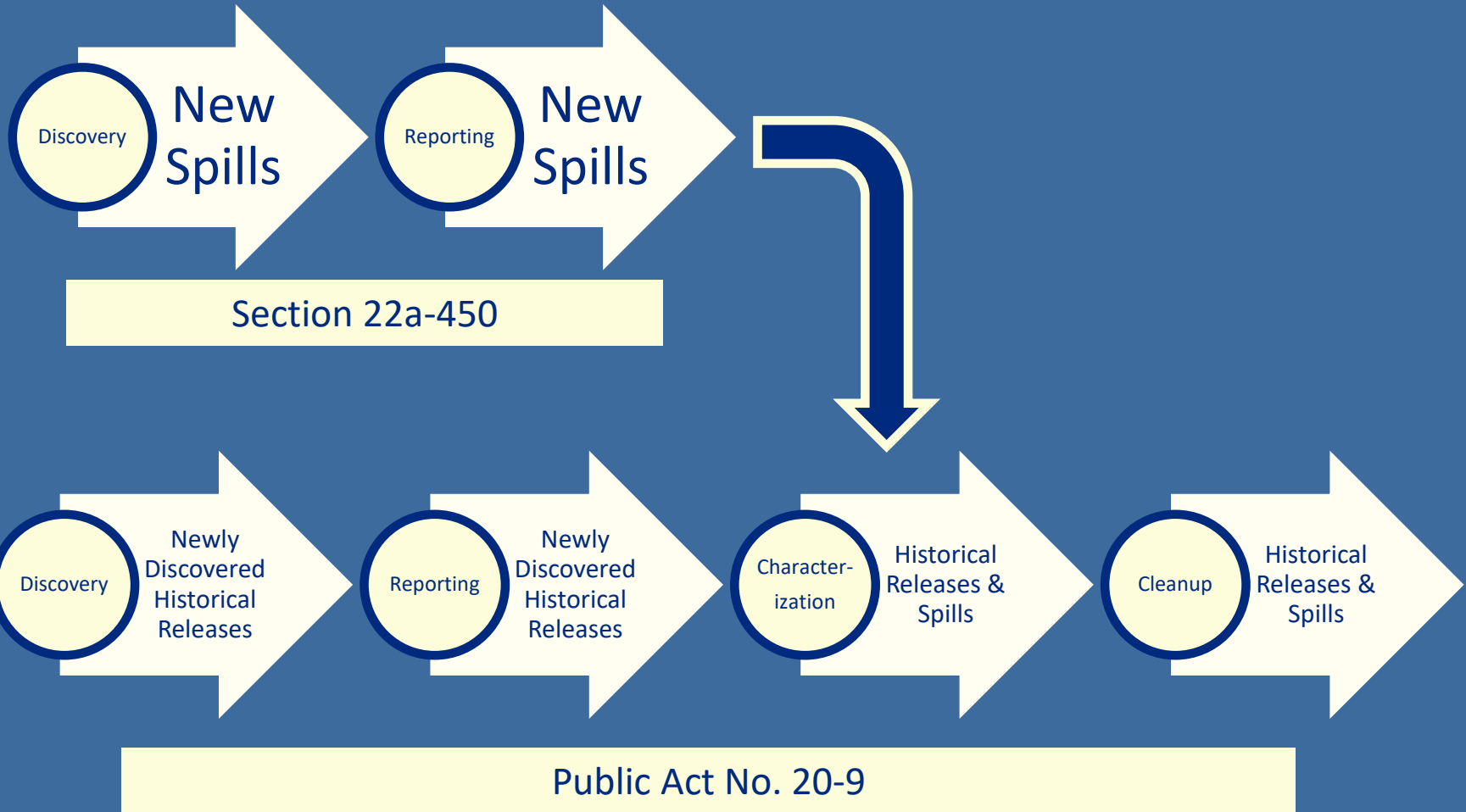

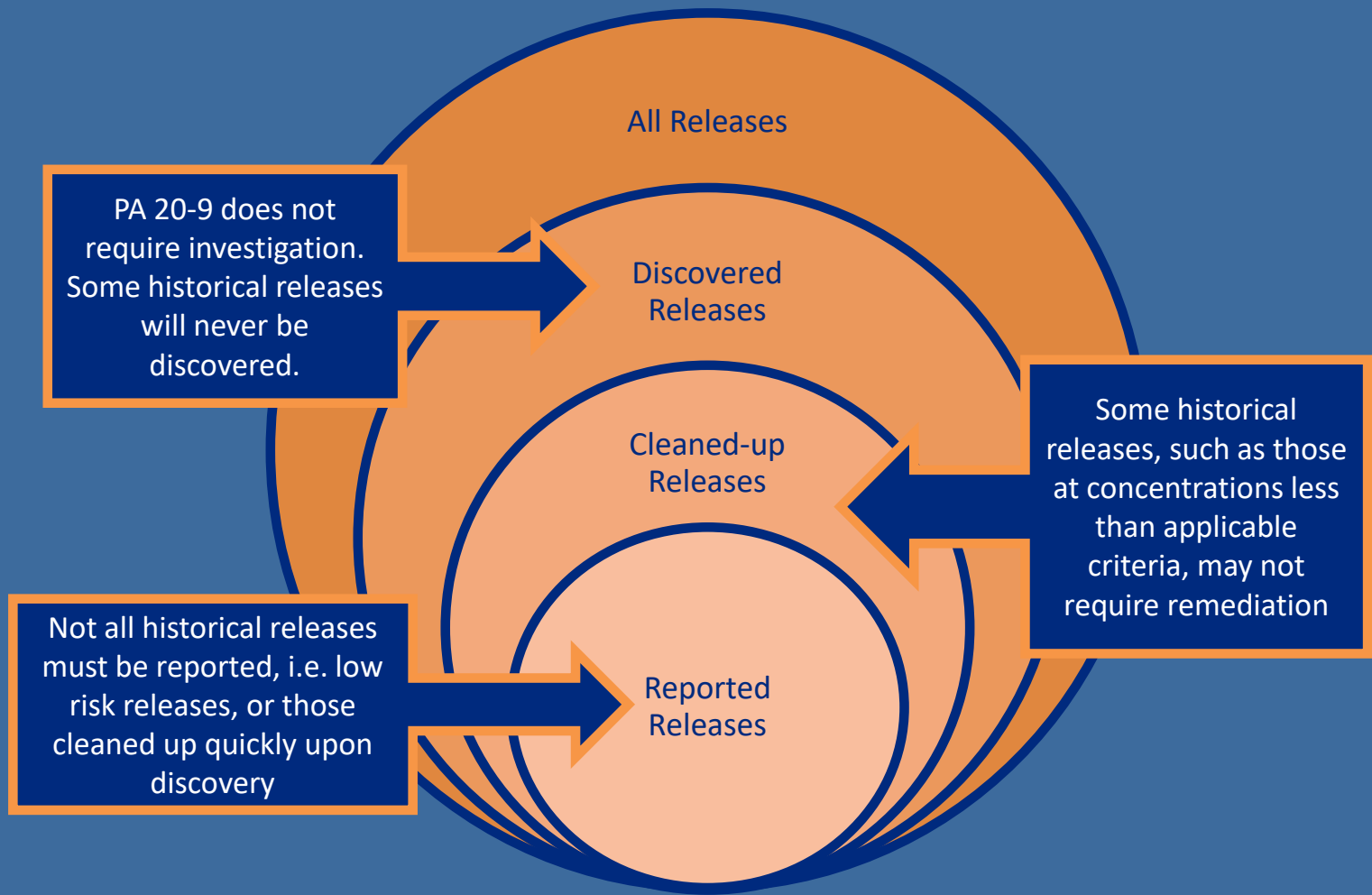

Not all releases will be discovered, not all discovered releases will be cleaned-up or reported.



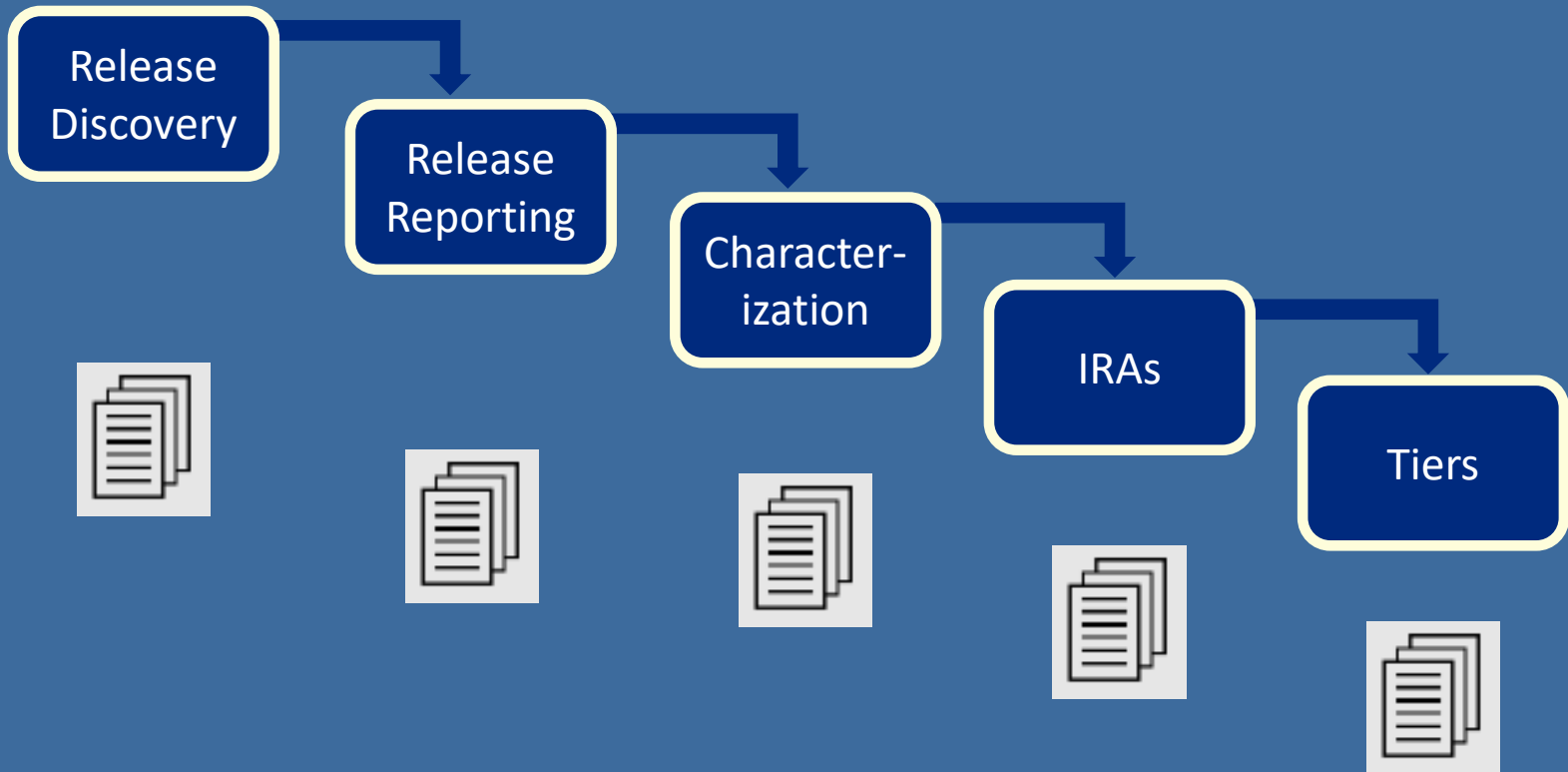

Linear Delivery

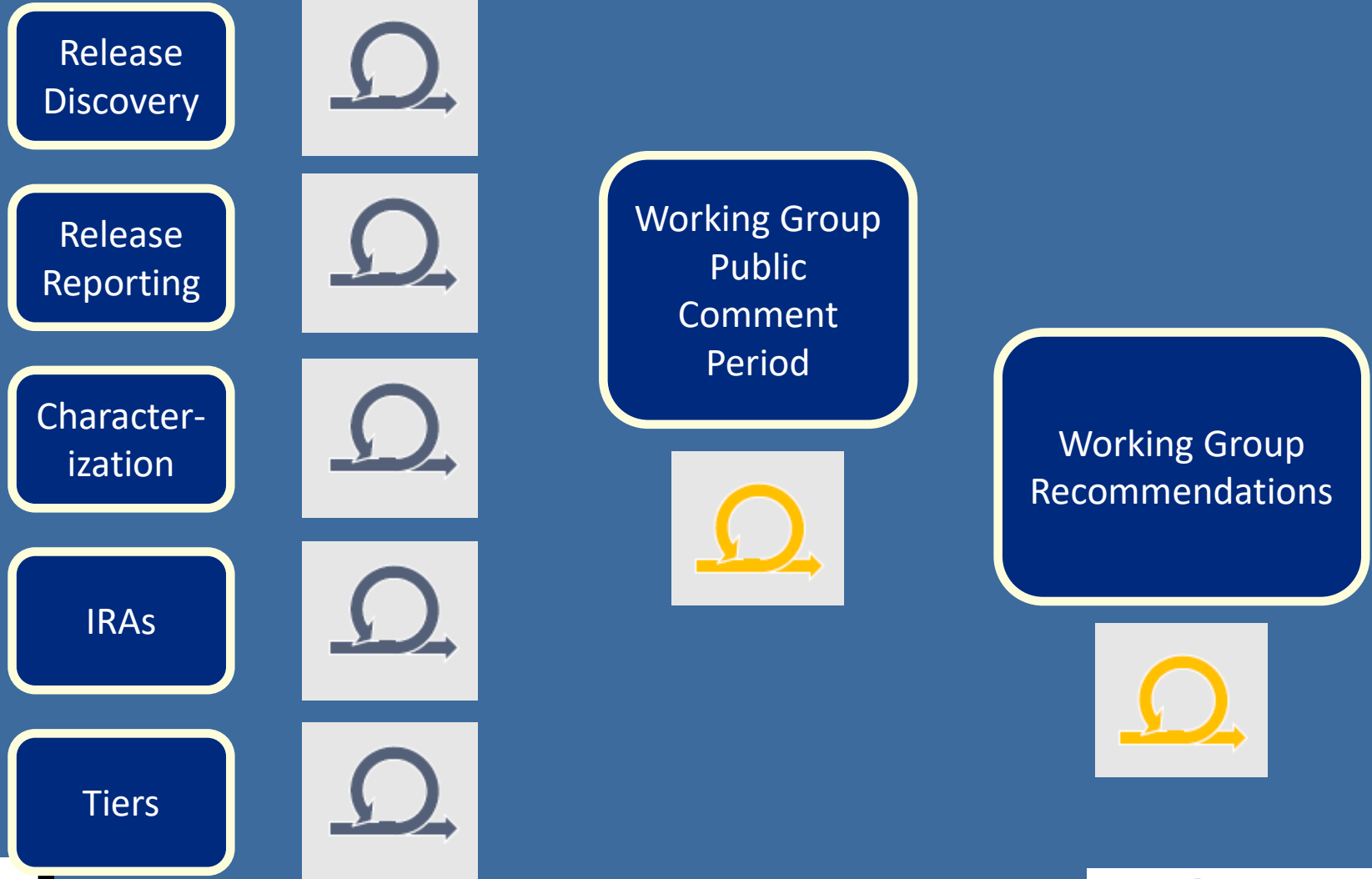

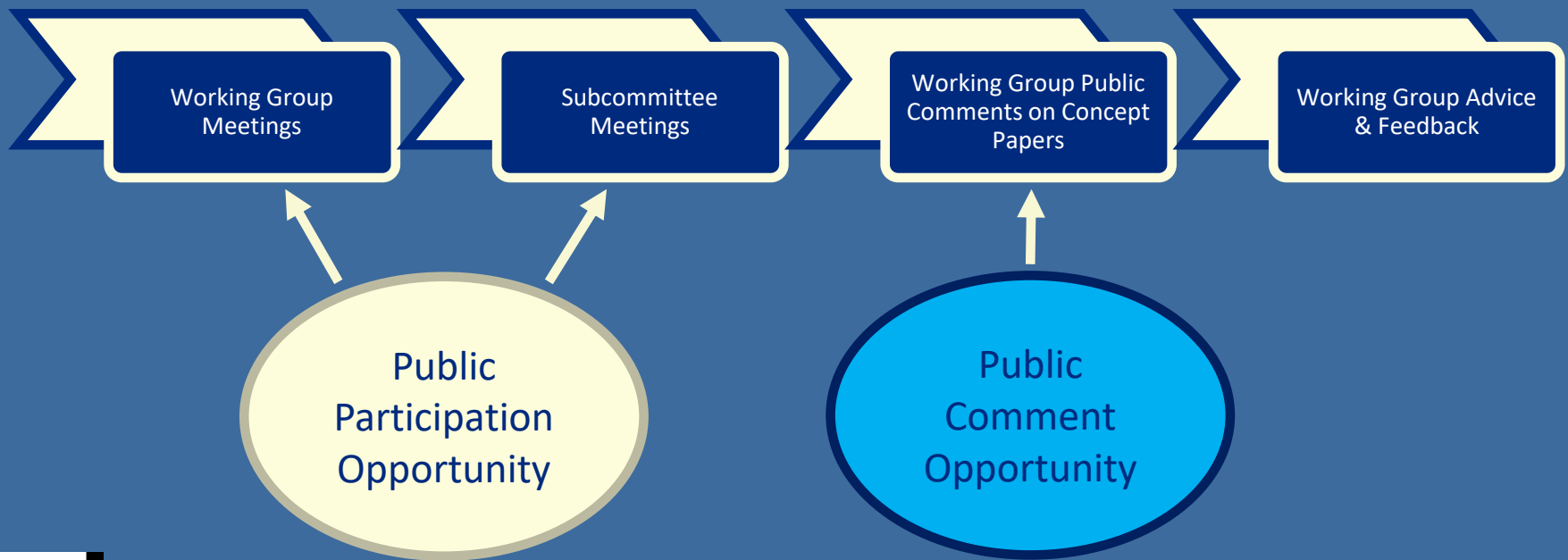

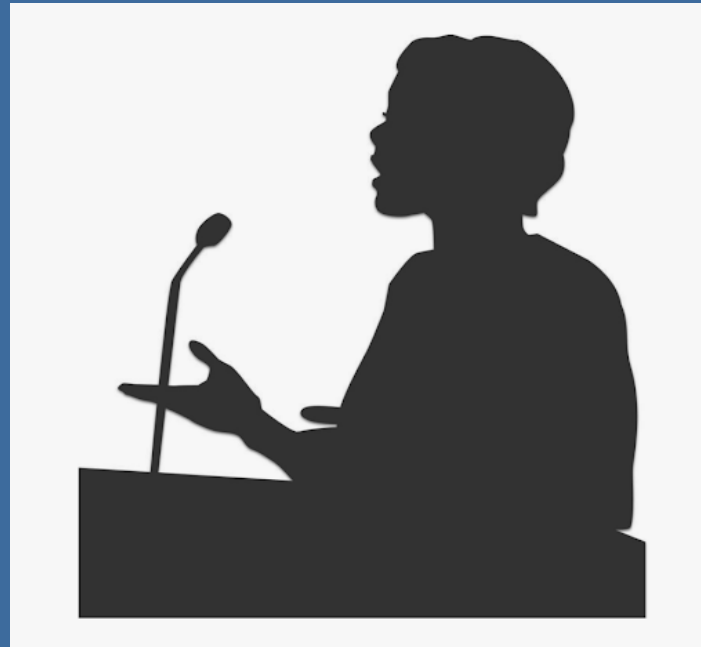

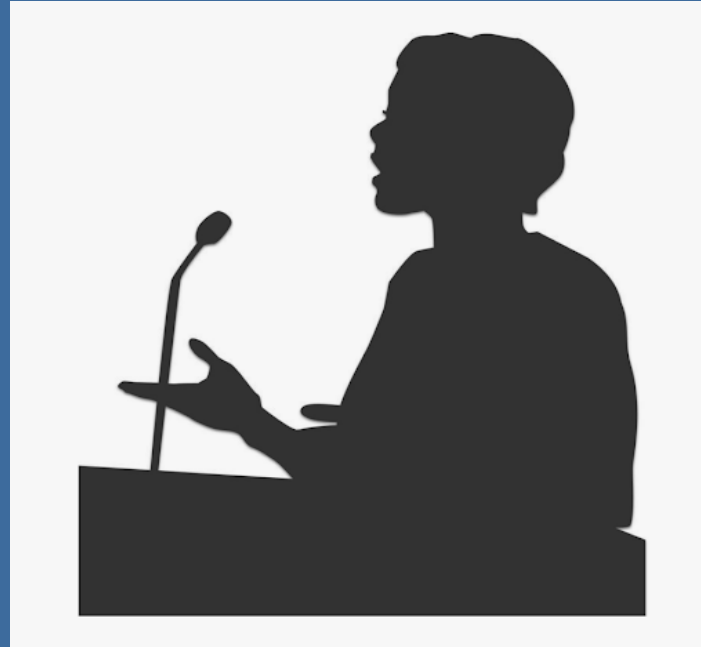

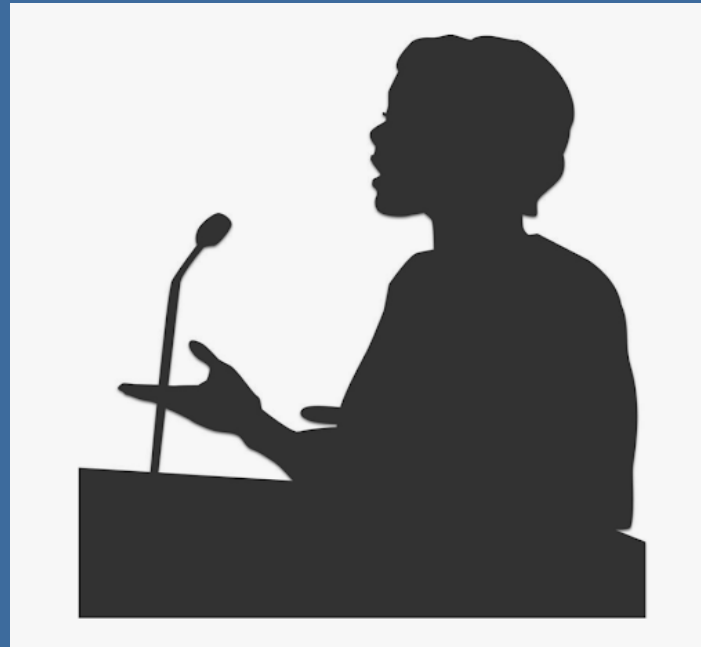

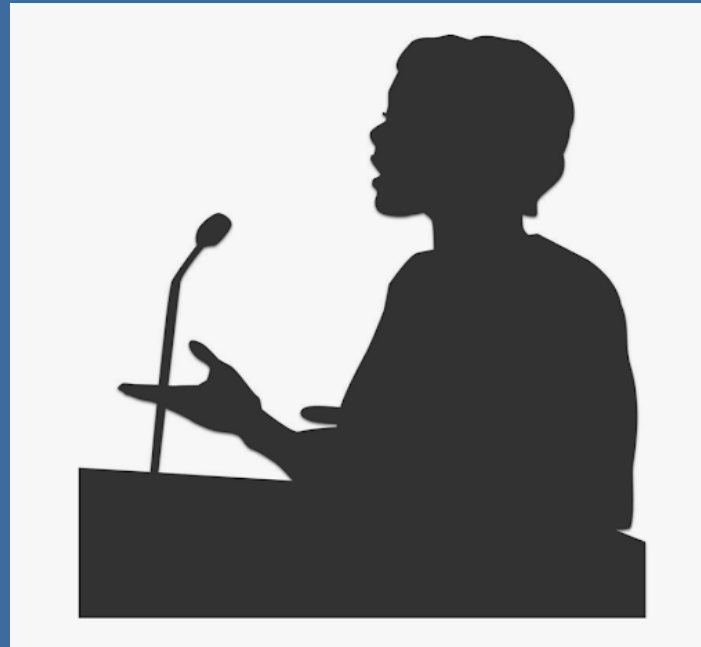
