- Advice and Feedback anticipated June 2022



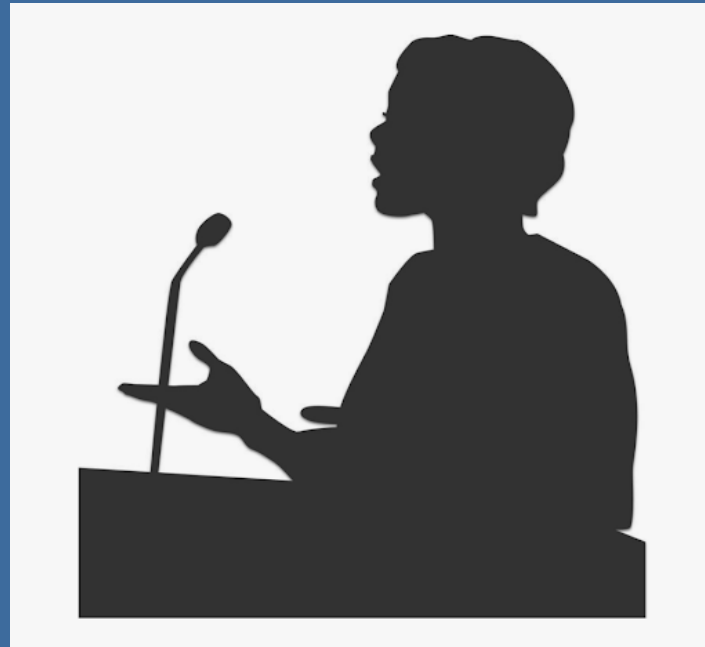

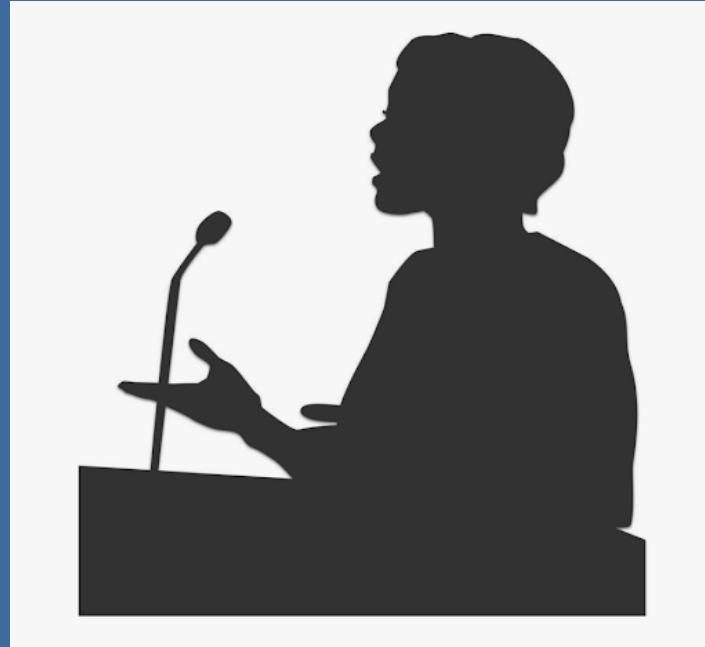

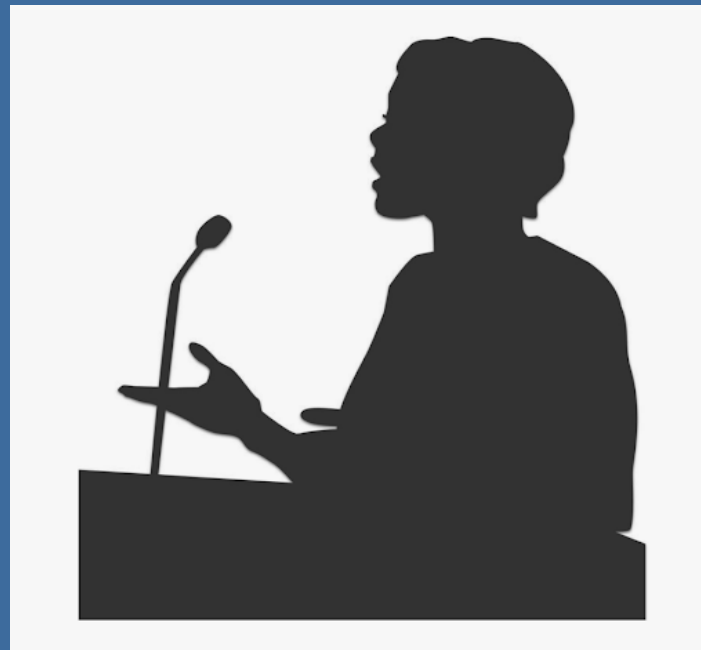
