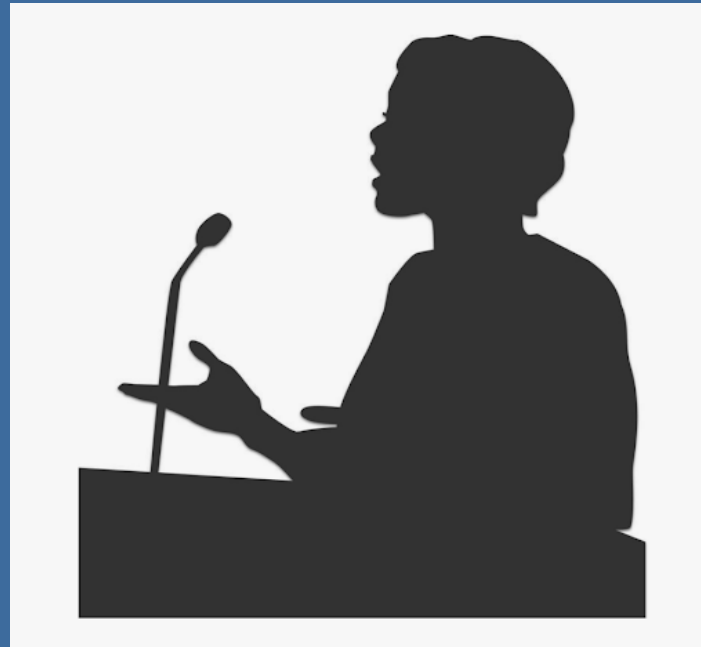
Risk Assessment

- Discussions at Subcommittee 6 and 7 have discussed desire to implement Method 3-type risk assessments in regulations
- DEEP submitting memo to Working Group today outlining our concerns, as this approach:
 - is not consistent with the release-based statute
 - is outside the DEEP's authority
 - is not necessary to the success of the release-based cleanup program

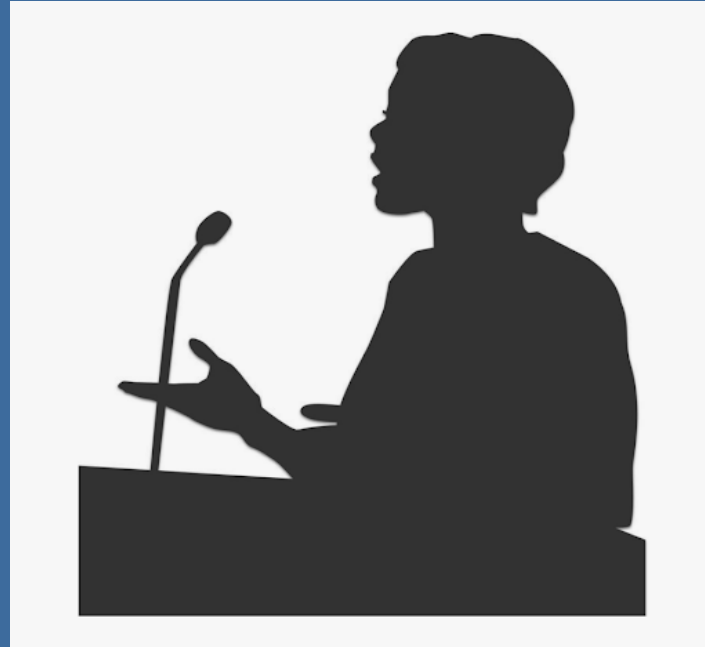

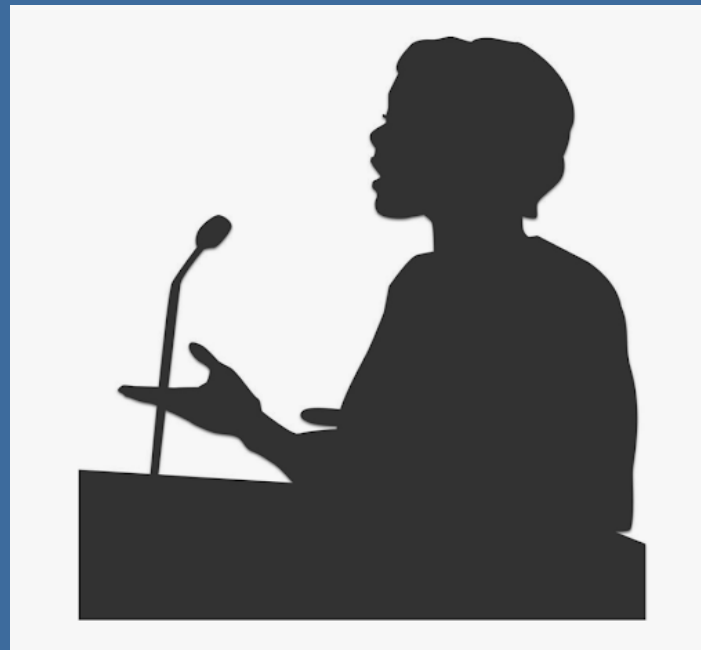
