Discussion: Review & Drafting Team

- Team of Working Group members that will:
 - Represent a diverse cross-section of stakeholders
 - Review Concept Papers for issue that may require modifications or alteration
 - Report to Working Group on proposed modifications/alteration
 - Draft document that transmits Concept Papers with Working Group-approved modifications/alteration



Discussion: Draft Regulation Review

- The Legislature passed HB 5124, which includes the requirement that DEEP:
 - DEEP shall provide a draft of such regulations to Working Group 60 days before going to notice
 - Working Group to provide advice and feedback on draft within 30 days of receipt
 - There shall be at least one meeting after DEEP shares draft regulations with the Working Group
 - DEEP shall provide a revised draft to the WorkingGroup prior to going to notice
