

 - Cumulative risk discussions
- Guidance/Form Development
 - Staff the Guidance and Form team
 - Staff DEEP's Characterization Guidance workgroup





Work Plan: What's Next-DEEP

- Review of Advice and Feedback and evaluate concepts in the context of statute, regulatory structure, and policy
- Present regulatory flowchart/framework every other month
- Regulatory Drafting: continue to draft pieces of regulations for 1st Phase Subcommittee concepts
- Standup Characterization Guidance team with Work Group members and staff Forms and Guidance team
- DEEP to launch team to work on notification system **for intake** and notification to other agencies, federal agencies, municipal officials, elected officials, and the public

- DEEP to update Working Group on:
