MINUTES

State Board of Examiners of Environmental Professionals

Regular Meeting – September 9, 2021

A. Call to Order and Sign-In

A regular meeting of the State Board of Examiners of Environmental Professionals (“the Board”) was called to order on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 9:40 via a Zoom conference call, by Chair Kenneth Collette. Board members J. Adams, M. Gamache, D. Wolfram and K. Meloy were present via Zoom. Board Administrator Liz McAuliffe, Jacques Gilbert, and Selena Thornhill-Moody of DEEP, and Nelson Walter representing EPOC were also present on the Zoom call for the meeting. This meeting is being held via Zoom due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the Governor’s Executive Orders prohibiting the physical gathering of persons.

B. Reading and Approval of the Minutes

The draft minutes of the Regular Board meeting of August 12, 2021 were read and approved with minor corrections; motion by M. Gamache, seconded by J. Adams, passed unanimously.

Mr. Walter reported that DEEP had published a document that clarifies the RSRs are applicable to all cleanup sites regardless of whether the remediation is conducted within a DEEP program or not. EPOC worked with DEEP on this document.
