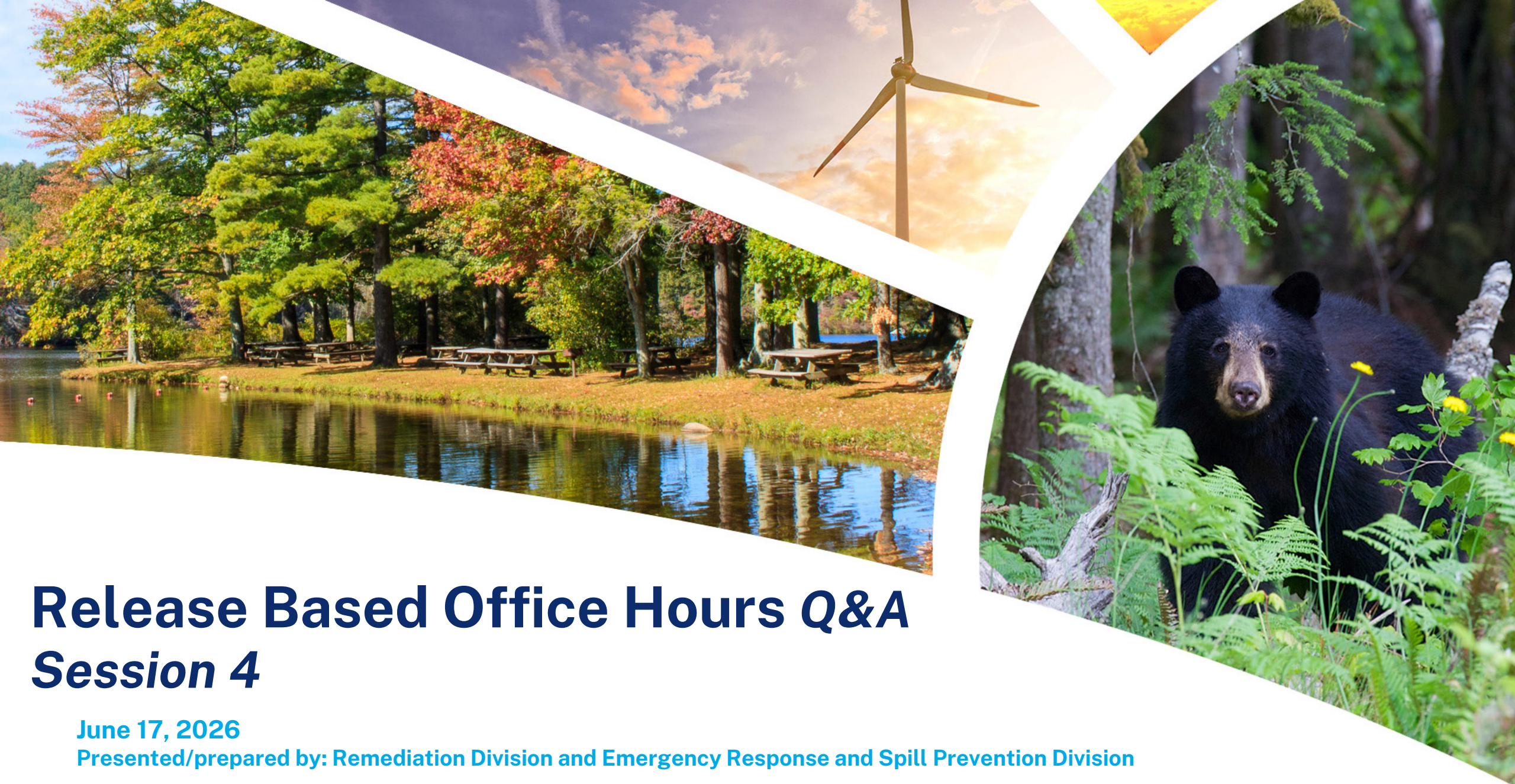

The following information was shared by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection on June 17, 2026. This presentation is intended to be an overview of the Release Based Cleanup Regulations (RBCRs) Sections 22a-134tt-1 through 22a-134tt-13 inclusive, and 22a-134tt-App1 through 22a-134tt-App12, which became effective on March 1, 2026. RBCR Q1

Q: Is there guidance on use of the upgradient regulation. Specifically, if you do not know the source of the upgradient release, or that entity no longer exists. What is the notification process to use the upgradient rule?

Answer:

- There is no guidance - refer to RBCRs [RCSA 22a-134tt-7(e)]
- There is no requirement to identify the source; only document that the pollution is coming onto the subject parcel
- Release needs to be reported in REACT (if required per RCSA 22a-134tt-3) and can be closed using provision with documentation
- There is no requirement to notify owner of upgradient parcel (so no issue that “entity no longer exists”)

RBCR Q2

Q: I have a client that is a buyer that wants to purchase a 30-yr old machine shop operation. The current owner will not allow sampling below the floor prior to acquisition. A few minor areas of staining were observed during a 2025 Phase I ESA that the seller has since cleaned from the floor prior to 3/1/26. The buyer plans to clean the floor upon purchase and seal with epoxy. If contamination below the floor is later discovered, would the buyer be considered the maintainer if it can be proven that the buyer had no documented spills and/or any spills were promptly cleaned to prevent migration. The seller owns 2 LLCs, one for the business and one for the property and will continue property ownership during buyer's occupancy.

Answer:

If contamination is found, the current property owner is a maintainer. In some situations, tenants may also be considered a maintainer.

RBCR Q3

Q: Regarding the need for the collection of 3 additional soil samples to demonstrate metals are background if a metal is detected above the low background but below the high background, is it permissible to use previously collected soil sampling results? At my site, we have detected several metals above the low background, and we have Phase II soil samples with similar metals analysis collected last year. The RBCRs do not put a time frame on the additional sampling.

Answer:

Yes, you can use the older data for the background demonstration. The goal of the sampling requirement is to make sure that there is a sufficient investigation/demonstration to make the background determination and, as you stated, there is not indication as to when that sampling needs to be done (so using existing data that meets the requirements will work).

REACT Tip

When a submittal is uploaded in REACT you can associate the submittal with the primary case and all related cases.

Q: In regard to SEH Status Update Form.

Does the documentation need to be submitted on the Significant Environmental Hazard Status Update Form(s)? Our client has a RCRA Corrective Action site, and we provide the Department an annual letter report (most recently submitted in January 2026) addressing the SEH conditions that remain at the site. The SEHs at this site predate the development of the update forms, so we have continued providing the updates in the original format we used.

Does it matter if the Electronic Transmittal Form(ETF) for DEEP Remediation, LUST, and PCB Secure File Transfer (SFT) identified RCRA Corrective Action as the Primary Program but did not identify Significant Environmental Hazard as a Secondary Program?

Answer:

While we would prefer you use the Update form to address the Hazard Case, if the Submittal document is intended to close out a Milestone specifically for the SEH case then it is important to upload that document under the Hazard Case and select the name of Milestone Submittal identified whether you choose to use the Update Form or not. The ETF is no longer being used, when uploading documents, you will be prompted to select any additional related cases you would like to associate with that submittal

REACT Q1

Q: I submitted a Progress Report, but it did not close out my Significant Environmental Hazard Status Update milestone?

- When Submitting Documents to close out a milestone take note of the exact name of the Milestone Submittal Type. It is ok if you called your report something else you just need to select the right submittal *type*.

REACT Q2

Q: Could you provide guidance on what the “Account” is –this is associated with setting up a LEP or EP as an Affiliation to a case?

Answer:

- The Account is either an individual person's name or the company name associated with an entity; such as a regulated entity. The Account identifies contact information.
- The regulated entity is the primary affiliate on a case.
- An environmental professional or other representative of the regulated entity can become an affiliate on a case by adding themselves as an additional contact on the case.
- The Regulated Entity is the Responsible party and/or the party doing the clean up on the property, and can be a business, Municipality, or an Individual Person. REACT will ask for the contact person and Billing Contact for the Regulated Entity to be identified
- Additional Contacts are the Professionals carrying out the work on the site on behalf of the Regulated Entity or other representatives that should be notified when activity is happening on a case.

REACT Q3

Q: Should ALL submittals now be through REACT (except due to file size?)

Yes. All submittals for all *cleanup* programs:

- LUST, PTP, Voluntary X and Y, Brownfields [ABC, BRRP, MBLR], Cleanup enforcement, PCB cleanup, PCB inspection followup, ERR followup submittals, SER Release-Based Cleanup cases, RCRA hazardous waste Treatment, Storage, Disposal facility cleanups, CERCLA cleanups, Federal facility cleanups, groundwater monitoring/landfill monitoring documents directed to the Remediation Division [see [Landfill Properties currently under Remediation Division oversight](#) list on DEEP website]

REACT Q4

Q: REACT is described as a bookshelf or library, though it also is used to receive online forms, such as LUST forms, SER/Immediate Action reporting, and Tier reporting forms. The LUST forms require a PEP or an LEP to "certify" the forms before they are registered as being completed in REACT. If cleanups are not yet completed, this appears to create a problematic situation where sites are unable to submit documentation of the work completed to the department through REACT when an LEP/PEP certification may not yet be appropriate. Can you please comment on this?

Answer:

REACT is a case management system that is used to track progress as well as to receive online forms, such as LUST forms, SER/Immediate Action reporting, and Tier reporting forms.

The REACT LUST submittals are through an online smart form that provide the information required by the cleanup sections of the UST regulations, replacing the previous paper submittal process. **Sites can submit documentation through REACT, including prior to the LEP/PEP certification.**

For releases from federally regulated USTs, once a submittal is completed in REACT, the LUST form should be printed, signed, and mailed to DEEP for compliance with the federal requirements.

REACT Q5

It looks like I'm already an affiliate on a case; but it is not showing on my home screen?

- Depending on when your name and email information was added into REACT a duplicate place holder account may exist in the system, especially for LEPs since a related information system used to issue licenses. Once you have officially logged into REACT and created your own account DEEP Staff will need to merge the account you created with the place holder account.
- To fix this: please email DEEP.REACT@ct.gov and DEEP Staff can merge the accounts and delete any other accounts that may be duplicative.

- You can add the correct regulated entity as an Additional Regulated Entity on the case with all the required information, then request DEEP Staff to delete the old information
- Also you can update/fix addresses and phone numbers
- Reach out to DEEP.REACT@ct.gov for Remediation Division Cases or DEEP.Leakingust@ct.gov for LUST or DEEP.PCBprogram@ct.gov for PCB cases with your requested changes.

REACT Q7

The information on the case record page does not look correct, how do I fix it?

- Once logged in you will see certain fields on the Case Record Page that have a pencil next to it, those are the fields you are allowed to edit yourself.
- Some fields can only be edited by DEEP Staff. In most cases we are allowing you to add information, but it is up to DEEP Staff to remove any information.
