Overview

Goals

- Ensure **public transparency**
- Modern **user experience**
- Streamlined **case management workflows** from creating cases and immediate actions through remediation and long-term stewardship
- **Improve communication** between property owners, their representatives, and DEEP staff
- **Reduce paperwork**

Components



Public Portal – Authenticated users (Property owners, LEPs, PEPs, attorneys...) can create **Cases, Milestones, Submittals**, and make **e-Payments**.

Public users (realtors, researchers...) can view all, though not create cases or make edits to data.



Staff Portal – DEEP Staff work in the portal to manage **Cases, Schedules, Milestones, Submittals**, and **Payments**.

REACT Elements

- Public can see simple lists, and conduct searches on properties
- Online tracking for Release-Based Cleanup Regulations elements and other cleanup programs
- Only Authenticated Users can upload documents (submittals)
- Free registration to become an Authenticated User
- Authenticated Users can report existing releases, submit documents, and view status and stages
- Public can view all data but cannot edit any information
- Multiple users can work in the same case if all are affiliated with that case

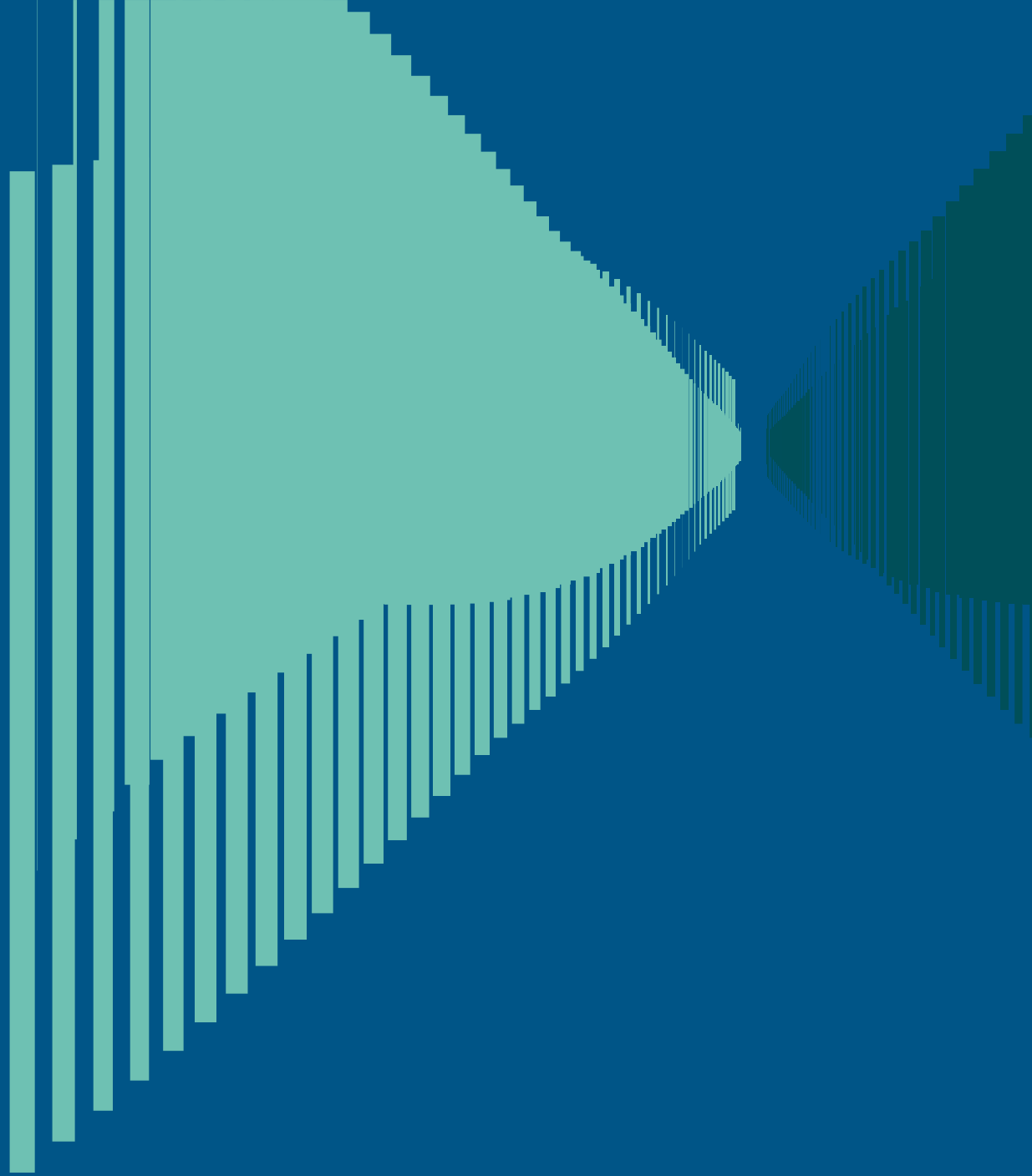

REACT, Sites, Cases



- REACT is a portal, not a regulatory program.
- **REACT** is a **bookshelf**.
- **Sites** are the **books** on the bookshelf, the place on the earth.
- **Cases** are the **chapters** within the books, the individual programmatic requirements.
