From Hartford: ●●

- Take CTrail Hartford Line from Hartford Union Station to New Haven Union Station
- Transfer to CTrail Shore Line East to continue to Madison Station
- Connect to 9-Town Transit 641 at Madison Station

From New Haven: ●

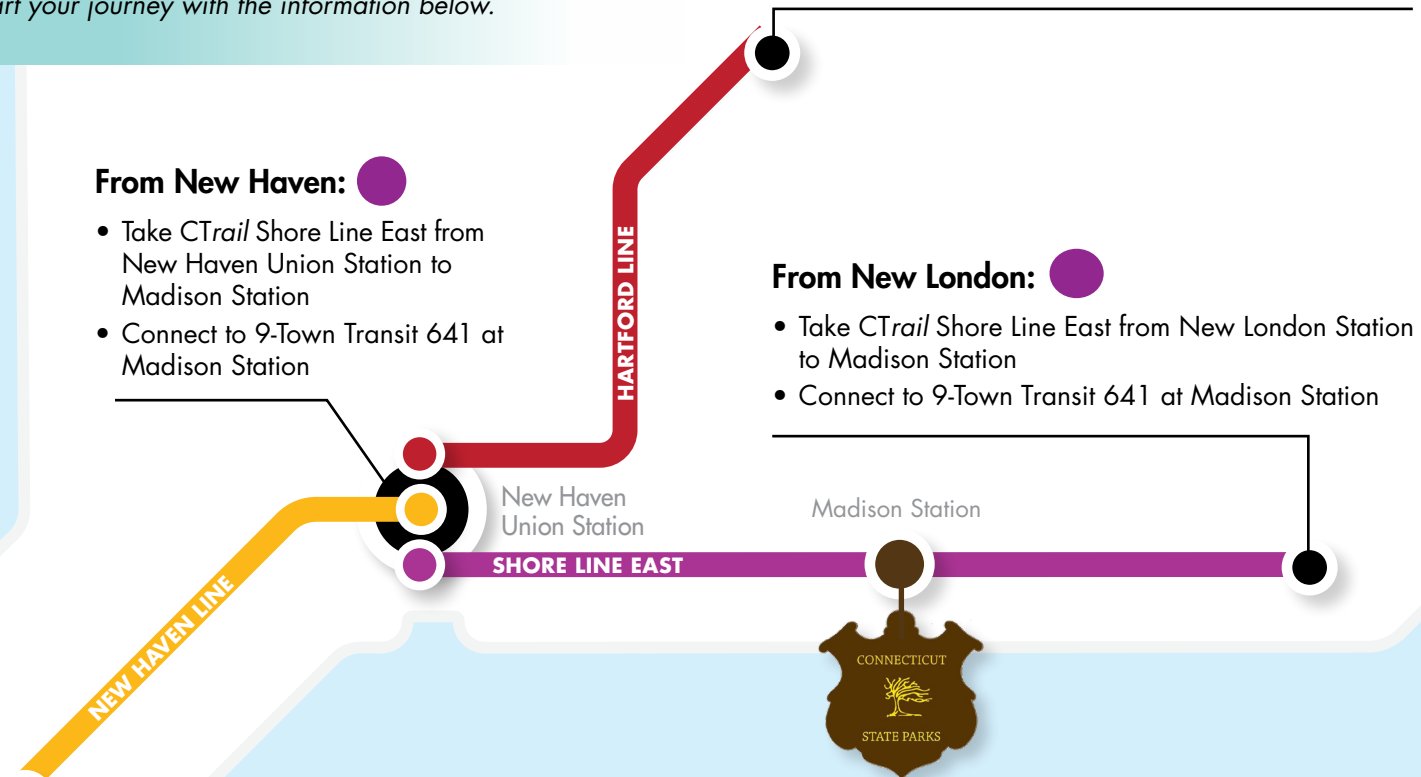
- Take CTrail Shore Line East from New Haven Union Station to Madison Station
- Connect to 9-Town Transit 641 at Madison Station

From New London: ●

- Take CTrail Shore Line East from New London Station to Madison Station
- Connect to 9-Town Transit 641 at Madison Station

From Stamford: ●●

- Take New Haven Line (Metro-North) from Stamford to New Haven Union Station
- Transfer to CTrail Shore Line East to continue to Madison Station
- Connect to 9-Town Transit 641 at Madison Station



Additional Information

- The 645, Madison Shuttle, and Clinton Trolley will stop at the Middle Beach traffic circle within the park
- 641, Old Saybrook/Madison: From the Route 1 & Hammonasset bus stop, follow the paved recreation path through the campground and to the beach (0.7 miles to the beach)
- Madison Train Station will also connect to the 645 on weekdays and Madison Shuttle 7 days/week
- Park admission is free when arriving by bus
- Madison Shuttle and Clinton Trolley are fare-free 7 days/week; all connecting bus routes are fare-free on weekends through Labor Day
