#### Glastonbury Food Waste Recycling Program

Through a new partnership with Quantum BioPower and All Waste, Glastonbury is now offering a residential food waste collection program. An enclosed container will be available at the Transfer Station for residents to dispose of raw and prepared foods. The Town will transport the material to a facility where the waste will ultimately be convered into a marketable, organic soil amendment product.

#### **Acceptable Materials**

Produce
Meats, Poultry, Fish
Liquid Waste
Fats, Oils, and Greases
Coffee
Dairy
Prepared Foods
Raw Foods

#### Not Accepted

Food Packaging
Plastic Bags
Film Plastics
Plastic Utensils
Aluminum Cans/Containers
Non-Organic Materials

\*This program supplements the Town's existing organic recycling efforts where brush is recycled into landscape mulch and leaves/grass clippings are composted to produce a soil amendment product. ## REFUSE/RECYCLING PROGRAM

#### Private Hauler

- Curbside Collection via Subscription Service
- Hauler Pays Tip Fee

Town Operated Transfer Station/Recycling Facility

- Permit System
- Fees Apply
- Approximately 6000 Waste Disposal Permits Issued Annually



### DISPOSAL

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) from Transfer Station to MIRA Facility \$91/Ton this Fiscal Year

Approximately 1550 Tons of MSW Annually from TS

Town Rents Container \$100/month
Container Hauled by Town
Town pays \$45 Disposal Fee to Quantum Biopower
Food Waste Collection Program Started Fall 2018/
12 Tons Collected Through June 2020
