October 20, 2020 Food Scraps/ Organics Collection and Diversion Working Group via ZOOM

I. Call to Order and Announcements

Meeting started at 1:00pm.

Co-chairs Katie Dykes, DEEP Commissioner and Ronald McDaniel, Mayor of Montville provided opening remarks, housekeeping rules and the agenda, introduction of the speakers and shared that over 40 responses have been received as part of the Public Engagement Questions- Request for Comment and Solutions located on the CCSMM webpage.

II. Committee Reports

Chris Field, Vice President, WeCare Denali presented on commercial composting systems and provided background on the WeCare Denali business of water solutions and composting services. The presentation covered the history of leaf collection and composting laws in CT and compared it to food waste composting. He spoke about contamination issues in the food waste and litter and strategies on reducing contamination. Chris received questions about sources of contamination, fees for their services and the scale of operations in CT and mechanical de-packaging.

Mike Bisi, Superintendent of Sanitation, Glastonbury, spoke about the Food Waste Collection Program in Glastonbury, the program started in 2018. The program started in parallel with SustainableCT efforts in the city. Mike spoke about the operating costs and tip fees and staffing for the waste and recycling programs in town. His presentation also covered a discussion of satellite containers, and how they are not manned and have high contamination rates. Mike covered how the town engaged and educated residents; home composting bins and rain barrels and partnership between UConn Master Gardener program. After the presentation, Mike received questions about performance over time, incentives and future goals for the program and fees for transfer station use.

Ariel Ardura, Clinical Fellow, Harvard Food Law Policy Clinic, spoke about the Harvard Law Policy Clinic and what they work on; she covered food donation laws federally and in CT as a way to reduce food waste overall. She also clarified that date labels are about peek quality not about safety and spoke about the history of date labels on food packaging and date labeling laws in CT; required for dairy products. Ariel was asked about best practices, how to support food scraps to donation scaling up; she highlighted

the Massachusetts platform to connect doners and donees. A comment was received about food waste to animal feed facilities in other states – why not in CT

Robert Isner, Director, Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division, DEEP, Overview of Public Comments. All public comments received to date are posted on the CCSMM webpage, he provided a brief overview of common themes including market development, contamination, mandates, funding, incentives, education, and permit structure.

III. Roundtable

There was opportunity for Q&A of the panelists. Working group members asked questions after each of the presentations.

Other discussion included next steps, including upcoming meeting dates and a reiterated request for members to attend the environmental justice presentation on October 28, 2020 at 1:00pm.

- school-based programs

Opened for discussion of any of the suggested focus areas and asked if municipal leaders might have interest in joining specific focus groups.

IV. Public Comment

Members of the public were asked to use the "chat" feature or the "raise hand" feature to indicate if they wanted to make a comment.

Questions from the public included the legality of feeding food scraps to pigs without heat treating it and also a question about PFAS contamination in compost and if the compost alliance tests for PFAS. Additional questions came up around packaging standards for compostable bags and food waste diversion to farms from schools and a comment was received about on farm digestion.
