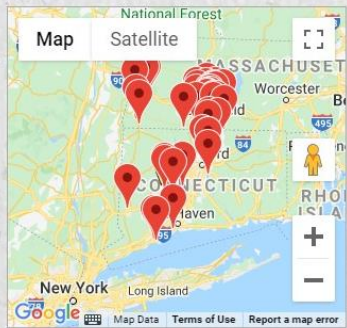

In the 2030 Solid Waste Master Plan, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) committed to establishing this workgroup to guide the development of a comprehensive Recycling Market Development Action Plan.
