 - C.G.S. Sec. 7-273aa et seq
- Single-town Authorities
- Interlocal Agreements
 - C.G.S. Sec. 7-339a et seq



Regional Waste Authorities in Statute

- Covered by CGS 7-273aa through 7-273pp
- "Municipal resource recovery authorities"
- Two or more municipalities can pass concurrent ordinances to create/join an authority



Regional Waste Authorities in Statute

- CGS 7-273bb gives Regional Waste Authorities many powers, including:
- Establish offices and hire staff
- Charge user fees for its services
- Purchase, lease, or rent property
- Construct, acquire, or improve infrastructure necessary to manage solid waste
- Own, operate, and maintain infrastructure




Regional Waste Authorities in Statute




Map of COGs
