Updates & Open Discussion/Q&A:

- Discussed the comments received on the Beneficial Use General Permits, the proposed changes and revised timeframes.
- Regulated Fill General Permit will be converted back into two separate general permits: One for Contaminated Soil and Sediment & Another for Asphalt, Brick, Concrete, Ceramics (Regulated Fill)
- Coal Combustion Products General Permit will be expanded based on comments received
- Bureau will be meeting with the Commissioner's office to discuss a different template for Waste General Permits
- Legislative proposals for Waste Demonstration projects, BUD authority and expanding the Solid Waste Fee to C&D that is disposed of either in or Out-of State.
- Waste Characterization Study currently does not include C&D, but a suggestion was made that SEP funds could finance the addition of C&D
- C&D speaker for this September SWAC meeting considering representatives from a Asphalt Roofing Shingle VRF and Tilcon
- Q&A regarding the Disaster Debris Management Plans and RFPs
- Shredder technology for oversized MSW/Hard-to-Manage waste items (mattresses, furniture, rugs) and possible Manufacturer Responsibility for these products in the future
- CRRA will be making an announcement and submitting a permit application regarding their new CT landfill location in the coming months
- Plasma Arc Technology St Lucie Florida project and the City of Hartford Plasma Arc Committee
