Open discussion following Matt McKinney's presentation:

- Sherill Baldwin introduced herself as a new DEP employee that will be focusing on C & D recycling.
- Discussion with Matt McKinney and others about markets to help facilitate and increase C & D recovery in CT
 - Why are markets not in CT for C & D? Not just permitting, but it costs more to recycle in many cases.
 - o IRN becoming more established in CT and as a result of them meeting high recycling rates with their projects, our markets may be saturated.
 - Markets in Mass. and elsewhere, but transportation makes these cost prohibitive, need more local markets.
- Ross Bunnell of DEP/WEED pointed out that recycling rates for C&D waste could actually
 be enhanced and the recyclability of the materials separated improved through increased
 compliance with various environmental, health and safety requirements that apply to
 renovation and demolition. He shared different printed materials (many of which are
 available on DEP website) for municipalities, contractors and the general public about
 environmental health and safety regarding renovation and demolition projects.
