SWAC E-Waste Update

Applications for Covered Electronic Recyclers

- Application period ended March 20, 2023
- No new recyclers applied
- All 4 existing CERs applied for renewal
- All 4 existing CERs were approved for 7-1-2023 to 6-30-2024

2022 Numbers

- ~ 8 million lbs. e-waste recycled
 - Total of 177 M since 2011



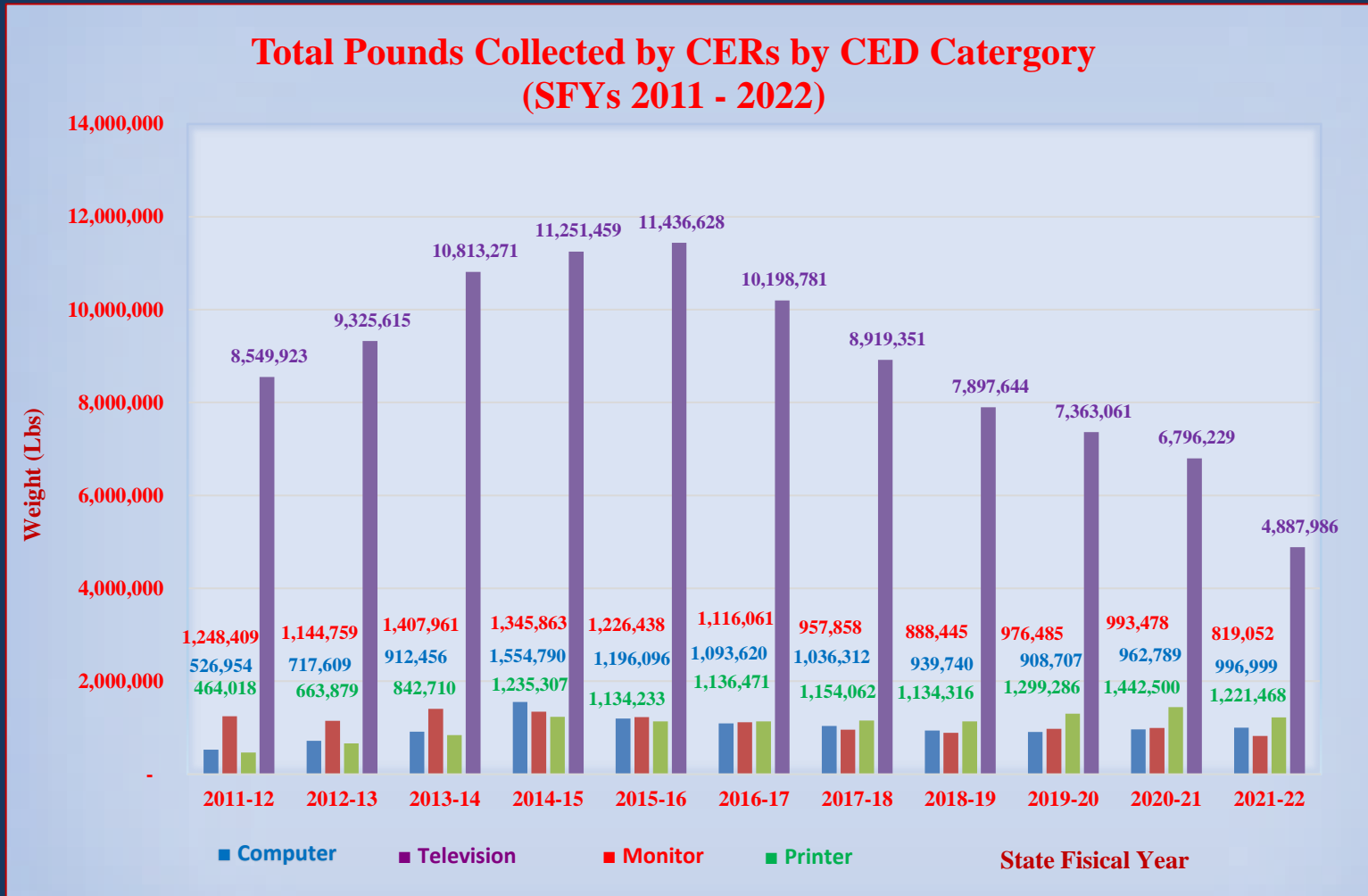
- Saved Towns ~ \$536,000
 - Over \$7.9 M since 2011



- 55 CT jobs (1 more since last year)

Scavenging Prohibited

- Scavenging not allowed
 - State solid waste law [RCSA 22a-209-7(i)]
 - Huge data security risk for previous users

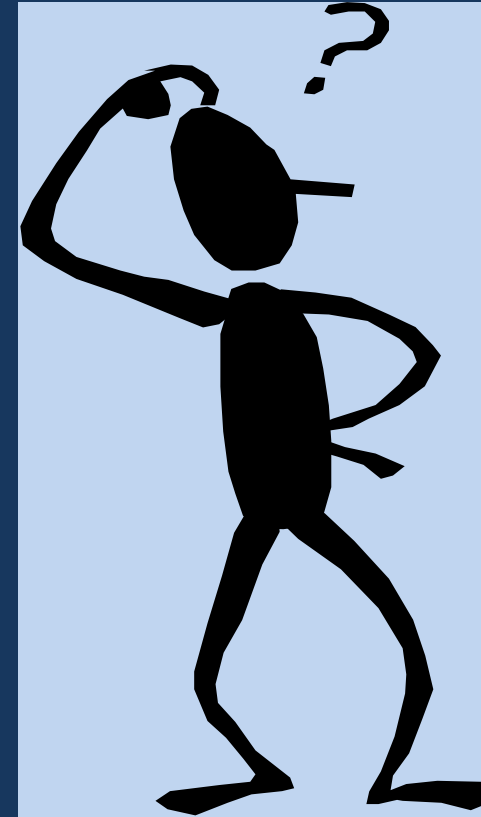
