Waste Legislative Update

- Legislation that passed:
 - ▶ **HB 6486** An Act Concerning Extended Producer Responsibility For Tires.
 - ► Bipartisan Support
 - ▶ **SB 1147** An Act Concerning The Environmental Justice Program Of The Department Of Energy And Environmental Protection.
 - ► Bipartisan Support
 - ► **HB 6664** An Act Concerning The Management Of Solid Waste And Establishing The Mira Dissolution Authority.
 - Passed, amended from Governor's version
 - ▶ SB 895 An Act Concerning Deposit Initiator Accounts And Carbonated Beverages.
 - ► Bipartisan Support
- Bond Bill:
 - ▶ \$15 mil new bond authorization for grants for municipalities for renovations and expansion of, and equipment for solid waste facilities



Waste Legislative Update

- Legislation that passed Committee but ultimately failed:
 - ▶ **HB 6606** An Act Concerning The Use Of Certain Products Made From Polystyrene
 - ▶ Died on a referral to Appropriations Committee
 - ▶ **HB 5577** An Act Concerning Surplus Food Donation And Establishing Food Composting Requirements.
 - ▶ Died on a referral to Appropriations Committee
 - ► HB 6608 An Act Concerning The Distribution Of Single-use Plastic Straws And Stirrers By Certain Restaurants.
 - Voted out of Environment but did not receive a vote in the House or Senate
 - ▶ HB 6609 An Act Concerning Extended Producer Responsibility For Smoke Detectors.
 - ▶ Voted out of Environment but did not receive a vote in the House or Senate
 - ▶ **SB 1046** An Act Concerning The Reduction Of Food Waste In Schools.
 - Passed out of Children's Committee, failed to receive a vote in Senate/House



Waste Legislative Update

Legislation Introduced this Session:

- ► HB 5571 An Act Concerning Reducing Plastics And Developing Connecticut's Economy In The Recyclable And Compostable Packaging Sector.
- ▶ **HB 5613** An Act Concerning The Disposal Of Certain Commercial Organic Wastes.
- ► HB 5618 An Act Establishing A Pilot Program For The Reduction Of Food Waste In Schools.
- ▶ HB 6814 An Act Concerning The Establishment Of A Coding System For The Designation Of Recyclable And Compostable Products
- ▶ SB 189 An Act Requiring Composting
- ▶ SB 1242 An Act Concerning Waste Management. (Same bill language as HB 6664)
- ► HB 5599 An Act Establishing A State Tax Credit For The Purchase Of Wildlife Deterrent Composter For Food Composting.
- ► HB 5600 An Act Concerning Human Composting Through Natural Organic Reduction
