

A sewage release is found.

Within 1 hour:

Within 2 hours:

Within 5 days:

1) Is the sewage release > 100 gallons OR has it reached a waterway?

If NO, skip to Step 2.

If YES, call the DEEP Emergency Response Unit **within 1 hour** at 860-424-3338; then move to Step 2.

2) Did the release reach water or may it come in contact with the general public?

If NO, skip to Step 3

If yes, contact the Chief Elected Official and the local health officials within 2 hours.

If yes, also contact all affected downstream Chief Elected Officials and local health officials within 2 hours.

3) Submit an electronic report to the DEEP SRTK online platform within 2 hours.

If the electronic reporting system is not functioning or an emergency prevents access to the system:

If or when system is working, enter 2-hour report.

Call DEEP Emergency Response Unit 860-424-3338 and speak to a live person if you haven't already.

Once the event impeding electronic reporting has cleared, go back to submit a 2 hour report to the DEEP SRTK online platform entering the time called and case #.

4) Always close out the 2-hour report within 5 days.
