Dennis Cuevas wanted to know where DEEP was on taking MS4s to NPDES permits. Rowland will check.

It was suggested that we have a meeting with Workgroup # 1 so they can present and explain their data.

Tim Dupuis wanted to see what level storm would be looked at for non-point systems. Steve Seigal felt that we should be looking at annual rainfall.

Margaret Miner wanted to make sure the non-point BMPs have some evaluation as to their durability and what extreme storm is used in their design capability.

Steve Seigal felt we should be looking at \$/lb P removed/MGD on an annual basis for presenting the various options.
