I wanted to let you know that we officially went out to public notice today with our proposed conversion of the Water Quality Standards into regulatory format. The public comment period ends on May 21, 2013. All documents are available at the website provided below. Also we have tried to highlight any changes in language that were necessary to support the conversion to regs.
