Appendix F. Certification that the Facility is Inactive or Unstaffed

To invoke monitoring or inspection exemptions for inactive or unstaffed sites, the permittee must indicate that the facility is inactive and unstaffed on their registration. If the permittee is already covered under this permit and the facility has changed from active to inactive and unstaffed, the permittee must submit for the commissioner's approval a revised registration changing the status of their facility to inactive and unstaffed. The permittee must also include a certification statement pursuant to Section 7(c) of the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater Associated with Industrial Activity effective on [Date to be Determined] ("the permit") indicating that the site is inactive and unstaffed, and that there are no industrial materials or activities exposed to stormwater. The official certification statement, in accordance with Section 7(c), can be found on the next page. This certification must be signed and dated by a qualified professional as described in Section 2 of this permit. The language of the certification must not be altered, and the certification as well as supporting documentation and correspondence with the commissioner must be included in the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan pursuant to Section 7(c) of the permit. If circumstances change and industrial materials or activities become exposed to stormwater or the facility becomes active and/or staffed, exception no longer apply and the permittee must immediately resume the requirements of contained within the general permit (e.g., inspections, monitoring, etc.).
