

Appendix K. Notice of Termination (NOT) Request

Instructions: This documentation refers to “Terminating Permit Coverage,” Section 7(h) of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CT DEEP) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater Associated with Industrial Activities (“IGP”). The permittee must submit a Notice of Termination (NOT) within thirty (30) days after one or more of the conditions listed below have been met. Termination must be received through NeT-MSGP. If submission through NeT-MSGP is unavailable, the permittee may sign (in wet ink) this document, scan it, and submit it via email to DEEP.StormwaterStaff@ct.gov. The permittee must ensure that all terms and conditions of this general permit will continue to be met until the permittee receives affirmative determination from the Commissioner that the permit has been terminated.

Reason for Termination:

- A new owner or operator has received authorization to discharge under this permit.
- The permittee of the facility has submitted and been approved for a “No Exposure Certification” (NEC).
- The permittee has modified the site such that all stormwater is retained on-site and there are no discharges of stormwater to surface waters of the state either directly or indirectly through an MS4.
- The permittee has ceased operations at the facility, there will no longer be discharges of stormwater associated with industrial activity from the facility, no materials associated with the industrial activity remain exposed to stormwater, and all sediment and erosion controls have been implemented as necessary (see Section 7(b)(8)).
- The facility falls under Sector J (Non-metallic Mineral Mining) and has met the applicable termination requirements per state and local regulations.
- The permittee has obtained coverage under an individual or alternative general permit for all discharges required to be authorized by a NPDES permit (unless DEEP revokes coverage for the permittee’s facility).
